

UNITED WAY SETS GOAL

The United Way Board of Directors, has set a goal of \$2,242,127 for the 1981 United Way Campaign Drive. This is a 9.2% increase over the amount raised in 1980 or \$189,350 additional new dollars.

The goal is set each year based upon recommendations from the Campaign Cabinet and from the Allocations Committee after assessing the anticipated needs of United Way member agencies for 1982. All persons involved in the entire process are volunteers representing all areas of the community. Charlotte Hill, President

of the organization indicated that this goal amount was, in effect, an approximate cost of living increase which would continue to fund United Way's 44 member agencies at the same level of this year. Future goals may need to be increased because of a lesser amount of federal funding available, she said.

Sherman Miller, Campaign Chairman for this year's drive, stated that with our local community's ever-changing needs, the \$2,242,127 goal was challenging but also realistic.

The United Way Board of Directors unanimously approved the goal for 1981.

JEWISH REPUBLICANS ENDORSE REAGAN PLAN

DETROIT (WNS) -- The newly formed National Jewish Republican Committee, under the chairmanship of Max M. Fisher, issued a statement this week endorsing the economic policies of President Reagan and urging support for the Administration's policies as outlined by the President.

Meanwhile, Max Fisher, in a letter to the publisher of an American Jewish weekly paper, expressed his outrage at the gross misrepresentation of his views regarding the proposed arms package sale to Saudi Arabia. "I am and have been totally opposed to the proposed arms package sale to Saudi Arabia. I believe it is against the strategic interest of the United States and that it jeopardizes the security of Israel, our only reliable and

dependable ally in the region," Fisher stated.

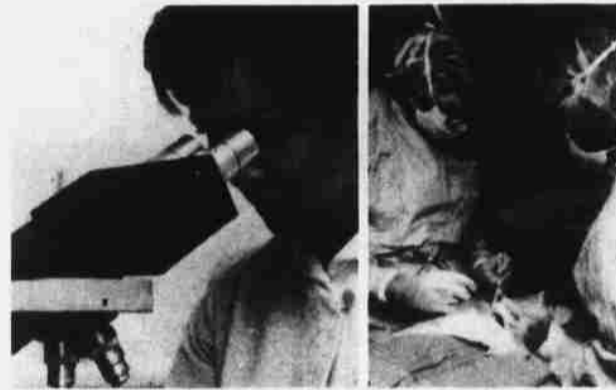
