## FRENCH WANT CAMP DAVID APPROACH

PARIS President Francois Mitterrand said that the 12 - month - old European Economic Community (EEC) initiative should not be considered as the only solution to the problems and be advocated the U.S. step - by styled step approach instead. He said he backed the U.S. peace effort and said the EEC should help Washington search for solution.

Mitterand speaking at the EEC summit meeting in Luxembourg said, "The Camp David approach is much better." He said however that he did not want to oppose the other EEC states but to seek a better understanding of the Middle East.

Meanwhile, the outgoing chairman of the EEC Council of Ministers said the EEC initiative can only proceed in conjunction with supplementary to the American initiative based on the Camp David accords. Dutch Foreign Minister Christoph Van der who will be Klaauw succeeded by British Foreign Secretary

Lord Carrington as chairman of the EEC, said that there is no room for an independent European ini-

tiative. He said he based his conclusions on recent trips to Israel and the Arab states.

## TERRORIST GROUP CITED FOR BOMBING

PARIS (WNS) -- The French daily, Le Quotidien, reported that an extreme rightwing Spanish terrorist group was responsible for the Rue Copernic synabombing last October 3 in which four persons were killed more than a dozen injured.

The paper quoted unidentified French and Spanish sources as naming four Spanish terrorists as the perpetrators. The report said two of the Spaniards planted the bomb for which Libyan ruler Muammar Qadaffi and the Pales-

tinians were originally blamed.

The police source said that they had followed the "Spanish lead" from the start but that it has led to nowhere as yet,

They said they showed photos of Mila Rodrigues, a wellknown Spanish rightwing activist and reputedly the gang's leader to eye-witnesses of the Rue Copernic outrage. But none recalled seeing him at the site before the explosion. Reasons for the attack are still unknown, Le Quoti-
