Don Rickles has been called the comedian's comedian. Every Rickles show is predictable in two ways -- non-stop laughs and an unpredictable performance as "Mr. Warmth" romps through a "non-routine" tailored to each audience.

From the razor-edged "matador" entrance, to his unrelenting assault on ringsiders, Rickles explodes the showroom with laughter, a commodity he then trades with his audience in his classic "Laughter for Love." His final toast to the brotherhood of all mankind leaves his fans more in touch with their own humanity -- and exhausted from laughter.

The Sandler and Young story has been aptly described as "an

implausible scenario." Indeed, it is. An incredible series of events led young Texan Ralph Young and young Belgian Tony Sandler to the Las Vegas Strip in 1963 where they were introduced to each other as the two lead production singers in a major new spectacular.

Their talents blended so well that the two strangers became an act, and eventually a classic team in show business.
