

600 LEADERS TO GATHER IN ISRAEL BOND FETE

More than 600 Israel Bond leaders from the United States, Canada, Western Europe and other countries will join with leaders of the Government of Israel in a celebration in Israel of the 30th Anniversary of the Israel Bond Organization from August 10 to 20.

Announcement of the anniversary conference, which will include visits to industrial projects built with Bond proceeds during the past three decades was made by Sam Rothberg, General Chairman of Israel Bonds, and Rabbi Leon Krohnish of Miami, Chairman of the 30th Anniversary Committee.

They pointed out that Bond leaders will be coming to Israel "not only to celebrate Israel's achievements as a result of our thirty-year partnership but also to discuss Israel's economic future, her energy needs, and the central role which world Jewry must continue to play in strengthening Israel's economy." The Bond campaign, which began in the United States in 1951 and is now conducted in many other countries, has provided over \$5.2 billion for every aspect of Israel's economy.

Among sites to be visited will be Har Ya'ir near Masada where conference delegates will participate in a dedication ceremony at the site of the eastern terminus of the projected Mediterranean-Dead Sea Canal energy project. In January this year, the Bond Organization undertook to provide the seed money for the project which is expected to meet 15% of Israel's energy needs.

Delegates will tour Ashdod and mark the 20th anniversary of the deep-water port which was begun in 1961 when Israel Bonds celebrated its tenth anniversary. They will visit the new power station in Hadera and the northern pumping station of the National Water Carrier, which were also constructed with Bond funds.

A highlight of the conference will be the Dinner with Prime Minister Menachem Begin and the Reception for delegates by President of Israel Yitzhak Navon at his official residence.

Also on the agenda will be briefing sessions with Cabinet Ministers, a Reception with Shimon Peres, leader of the Labor Party, a Dinner with noted author Elie Weisel as the special guest and a Reception by Mayor of Tel Aviv Shlomo Lahat.

Conference participants will witness a magnificent sound-and-light show at Masada depicting the heroic struggle for freedom waged over 1900 years ago by Jewish defenders of the fortress.

The delegates will also visit the gravesites on Mt. Herzl of the late Prime Minister Golda Meir and the late Finance Minister Eliezer Kaplan, who, together with the late Prime Minister Ben-Gurion, were the principal architects of the Israel Bond campaign.

They will take part at Yad Vashem in a special memorial ceremony to the six million Jews who perished in the Holocaust.

Leaders of local Bond campaigns in the early 50's as well as outstanding community leaders during the past 30 years will be honored at conference sessions.

FRENCH RACIST CONVICTED

PARIS (WNS) -- Robert Faurisson, a 52-year-old French historian has been convicted by a French court of inciting hatred and racial discrimination in connection with a book he wrote last year in which he claimed that reports about the Holocaust are "grossly exaggerated" and that genocide was not a policy fundamental to Nazism, it was reported here.

Faurisson was given a 90-day suspended sentence and fined \$900 by the Correctional Court of Paris. He was also ordered to pay a total of \$3,500 to three French Jewish organizations that had filed suit against him for spreading "racist theories."

Meanwhile, in Brussels, it was reported that a right-wing militant who spread propaganda that the Holocaust never occurred, was sentenced to two years imprisonment by a Court of Appeals for incitement to racial hatred. The defendant, Jean-Robert Debaut, had appealed an 18-month sentence imposed earlier by a lower court. But his appeal was rejected and six months were added on to the original term.
