DIANA ROSS, also magnetized by RIKLIS from Caesars, makes her heralded bow Aug. 20 for 10 days and she'll waltz away with \$500,000, one of the highest paid entertainers to play the Riv. Remaining four days of the regulation two - framer will be filled by BUDDY HACKETT and TINA TURNER.... The WAYNE NEWTON on/off-off/on deal is off again. He and RIKLIS started talking four months ago... RIKLIS is quite frank about his high salary carrot stick for topliners: "I didn't go to the other hotels and say I'd steal this guy or gal. I just went around to find out who can I get at the price I can afford, I sat down with a paper and pencil and did things that other hotels may not have done for years because they live with it. I'm the new kid on the block, I can think differently." Other than AITS which governs the Riv, RIKLIS is boss of Rapid American, a combine which grosses \$2,500,000,000 a year.

The Aladdin took back LOLA FALANA through the 19th, then it's the debut of TEDDY PENDERGRASS & STEPHANIE MILLS. JOAN RIVERS, who closed her smasher costarring with LOLA FALANA the other Wednesday, now toplines Harrh's Reno with FRED TRAVALENA. In the Theatre for the Performing Arts "1000 Years of Jazz" blows in on the 28th for a two-nighter. MAC-DAVIS, who finished wailing at

MGM Grand with Lonnie Shorr Wednesday, taped his NBC Xmas spec long before the snow flies, in May to be exact, a couple of days after etching his new Casablanca vinyl.
