Call Secret Witness
386-3213

This week Secret Witness will pay \$1,000 cash reward for information leading to the arrest and indictment of the person or persons that have committed the following crimes:

On Tuesday, August 4, 1981, at approximately 11:00 p.m., there was a robbery at Decatur Liquor, 546 Decatur Blvd., So. Three black male suspects walked into the business.

Two were armed with shotguns and the other armed with a handgun.

The three suspects proceeded to rob the bar and the patrons brutalizing many of them.

During the robbery, Thomas Turk, a local retired musician, was shot in the head and killed. An off - duty Metro police officer was also wounded in the gunfire.

The three suspects are in their late teens or early twenties and were driving a vehicle described as a 1979 black over beige Buick with the left tail light broken showing white light.

On Tuesday, August 4, 1981, at 8:30 p.m., Dorre Carl Thomas was the victim of a severe beating at his residence on Teepee Lane. He was attacked and beaten with a length of pipe or iron bar.

As a result of the beating Mr. Thomas suffered lacerations of the forehead, mouth and severely broken right leg.

Mr. Thomas had been an employee at the Imperial Palace Hotel. There were two white suspects involved in the beating described as in their late twenties or early thirties, approximately 5'10" to 5'11", approximately 170 pounds.

On Tuesday August 4, 1981, Beal's Royal

Glass & Mirror Co. reported the theft of \$10,000 worth of windows stolen from a fenced lot at Valley View and Misa Vista some time between July 31 and August 2, 1981.

The windows all have a grand name "General." The chain that secured the gate had been cut off and different types of assorted windows were removed from the storage area.

Between the 4th and 5th of August 1871, a residence on West Sawyer Avenue was the victim of a burglary and the following property was taken:

A .22 caliber "Rugar" automatic pistol, 4"

A handmade violin, orange varnish, brand name "Guarnieri Ferdinand."

A handmade viola, orange varnish brand name "Guarnieri Ferdinand."

A violin, brand name "Cabass."

A alligator violin case, dark redish color with red velvet cloth cover.

Numerous handmade violin bows.

The violins had grafted necks, making necks longer. All of the property was of sentimental value to the owner. The thousand dollar reward will be paid either for arrest of suspects or the complete recovery of the musical instruments.

Anyone that may have information pertaining to any of the crimes mentioned is asked to call the Secret Witness Hot Line, 386-3213. Callers do not have to reveal their identities in giving the information or collecting the \$1,000 cash reward.

Secret Witness will also pay cash rewards on other major crimes or crimes that are being planned.
