PARIS (WNS) --Minister Foreign Claude Cheysson wil' visit Israel and Egypt, Secretary Elysee General Pierre Beregovoy announced. Israel's Ambassador to France, Meir Ro-senne, is due to meet Cheysson to arrange for a tentative date and his program

The decision to send Cheysson to Israel and Egypt was reportedly taken by President Francois Mitterand who is upset by the wave of unrest

and protests which has swept through part of the Jewish community and Israel's friends. The president of the major pro - Israeli friendship organization. Gen. Jean Lecompte. who heads the France - Israel Alliance. wrote Premier Pierre Mauroy to protest what he considers to be the government's pro-Arab slant and called for Cheysson's resignation.

Jews were also upset by Cheysson's scheduled meeting with Palestine Liberation Organization Chief Yasir Arafat and by the endless stream of Arab dignitaries visiting the Elysee while no direct contacts on a ministerial level have been established with Israel tion last May,

The French President conferred at lunch with the Emir of Qatar, Sheikh Khalifa Bin Hamad. After the meeting a French spokesman said that had said Mitterand that certain elements in the Saudi Arabian peace plan, as proposed earlier this Crown month by Prince Fahd, contained "positive elements." Elyssee spokesman Beregovoy quoted Mitterand as saying "Peace is always preferable
