SEN. CANNON AGAINST AWACS

WASHINGTON - Nevada Senator Howard Cannon cosponsored a resolution disapproving the proposed sale of AWACS to Saudi Arabia.

The resolution, signed by some 40 senators, states that the sale "risks jeopardizing our national security and further destabilizing the Middle East."

Cannon has opposed the sale since it was first suggested several months ago.

"I do not want to risk having our most sophisticated radar aircraft fall into the

BEGIN SPEAKS ON AWACS SALE

WASH. (WNS) -- Premier Menachem Begin said that the Pentagon official who said that Israeli-U.S. strategic cooperation worked out between President Reagan and the Israeli Premier would be "jeopardized" should the Administration's proposal to sell AWACS planes to Saudi Arabia be blocked by Congress, "didn't know exactly what he was talking about." The unnamed official's statement was carried in recent newspaper reports.
