vations "constitute a serious obstruction to achieving a comprehensive and just peace in the Middle East as well as a threat to international peace and security."

A ridiculous charge. The entire scientific-educational world knows that the excavations conducted by Israel in Jerusalem are historically important for the world of science and do not affect peace in any way.

The one-sided resolution, unbelievably, was adopted by 101 votes in favor to 2 against with 23 abstentions. Egypt, which might at least have abstained, voted with the 101. The European Community of Ten, however, was among the 23 that abstained. This marks a slight change in attitude vis-a-vis the Palestinian question.

The United States stood out as the single UN Member to stand by Israel in voting against the resolution. Benjamin Gilman, the American spokesman in this Committee, in explaining his opposition to the resolution, stated that he saw no compelling reason for the UN to take up the

draft now. He said that the Committee was now in the final day of considering a most complex item on questions relating to Information, and he noted that it was yet to receive the Secretary-General's report on the item. "The draft was out of order," he emphasized.

Mr. Gilman informed the Committee that the Board of UNESCO had already debated at length the question of the Jerusalem excavations at its meeting in Paris last month and that, according to a report of the Director-General's special representative, Israel had brought no damage to the holy sites such as the sponsors of the resolution alleged.

The Canadian delegates, who were among the 23 that abstained, took the Arabs to task by reprimanding them for having introduced their resolution "with such haste." He charged that it levied serious accusations regarding a subject of utmost importance, both historically and culturally, to a large proportion of mankind.

Thus, as we see, the UN 'show' is on and the world will witness a 'repeat performance' of a spectacle poisoning the UN atmosphere, with bitter words of hate directed against the Jewish State by the modern counterparts of Esau, Ishmael, Antiochus Haman and the many

other enemies of mankind. Despite their threats of annihilation, they will find out soon enough that Israel has a Watchman, a Protector -- the very Same Who guided them from Egypt through the Exodus unto the Land which He swore would be their everlasting Homeland -- a Homeland unto which they have now returned after 2,000 years of exile. Whoever opposes this Return opposes the One Who pledged this Return
