AWACS BRING OUT ANTI-SEMITISM

-- Allegations that anti - Semitism had surfaced among some U.S. Senators constituents during the heated AWACS debate last month was supported by a report released Nov. 15 by the Anti - Defamation League of B'nai B'rith. At the same time, the report revealed that the mail ran more than 2 - I against the sale. Seventy - two Senatorial offices provided the ADI with data on their anti - Semitic mail and 61 of these provided data on letters critical of Israel.

In London, speaking on British Independent Television Carrington said that there was a "good chance" that PLO chief Yasir Arafat would agree to guarantees Israel's security in a Middle East peace settlement. He said that any Arafat to that statement affect would have to he "good words" if they were to remove Israel's "legitimate fears' that the PLO's ultimate goal was Israel's destruction. He said mutual remutual recognition of each other by Israel and the Palestinians was indispensable.
