notes further that the European powers neither committed themselves to nor excluded themselves from other peacekeeping machinery which might be brought into the area; and finally, the offer to participate in the MFO was made without prejudice to European policies concerning a Middle East settlement.

Further British comment emanated from Washington where Douglas Hurd, Minister of State for Foreign and Commonwealth affairs, the second ranking official at the Foreign Office, held a press conference at the British Embassy Hurd, who specializes in Middle East affairs, denied that the Anglo-French-Italian-Dutch announcement implies opposition to the continuation of the Camp David process. He said the four countries were only pointing

out that they were joining the MFO to help implement that part of the Camp David agreements which calls for Israel's withdrawal from Sinai and were "not passing any judgment on the rest" of the Camp David accords.
