The Welfare Minister, who heads the Tami Faction, a coalition partner in Pre-Menachem mier Begin's Likud lead government, took leave of absence from his cabinet after trying in vain to have the trial postponed. Abu - Hatzeira was acquitted of charges of bribe taking in a trial earlier this year.
