

SHABBAT ON VIDEOTAPE

Now, for the first time, there is a way for Jews who cannot go to the Synagogue to have the Synagogue come to them.

Jews who are confined by illness or infirmity in hospitals, nursing or convalescent homes, senior citizen homes and other health care facilities can now participate in a Shabbat Service presented on videotape cassette. Rabbi Wayne D. Dosick of San Diego, California, proudly announces the creation of THE VIDEO SYNAGOGUE to bring Jewish worship and Jewish community to Jews who are otherwise isolated and alone.

The videotape cassette contains a forty-five minute Friday Evening Sabbath Service conducted by Rabbi Dosick with Cantor Barry M. Caplan. The complete prayer Service includes responsive readings, with easy-to-read graphics appearing on the screen, traditional melodies, songs and sing-alongs and an inspiring message from Rabbi Dosick. A full Congregation, includ-

ing people of all ages, participates with the Rabbi and Cantor, giving the viewer a sense of being in a Synagogue with a community of Jews. The Sabbath Service on videotape is in full color and is set in an artistically attractive Synagogue. Beautiful and picturesque background scenes add to its visual and aesthetic appeal.

Rabbi Wayne D. Dosick has served pulpits in La Jolla, California and Wilmington, Delaware. He is a Past President of the San Diego Rabbinical Association, a founder of the San Diego Jewish Academy and is a member of the Rabbinical Assembly and the Central Conference of American Rabbis. Listed in Who's Who in World Jewry, Rabbi Dosick is one of America's most gifted young Rabbis, a dynamic, enthusiastic, loving preacher and teacher.

Rabbi Dosick states, "Every Jew who has ever been in a hospital, anyone who has had a relative confined by illness, every Rabbi who has visited congregants

in health care facilities shares the same frustration. The misery of illness is compounded by the misery of loneliness and isolation from family, friends and Jewish community. There is nothing sadder than a Jew in a hospital on Shabbat or a major Jewish Holiday.

Videotape cassettes are produced in a wide variety of video formats and can be shown on closed circuit television or by means of a portable videocassette recorder. UJA SECOND ANNUAL SUPER SUNDAY

NEW YORK, N.Y. -- With less than two months remaining before United Jewish Appeal's second annual National Super Sunday on January 17, 1982, planning is picking up steam, according to Jerome J. Dick, UJA National Super Sunday Chairman.

On Super Sunday '82 which marks the opening of the "public phase" of the 1982 Campaign in many areas, volunteers from all over the U.S. will make thousands of telephone calls in an attempt to reach as many Jewish households as possible.

"Super Sunday '81 was an overwhelming success," said Dick who was also chairman of the first national phonathon last

January. "More than 25,000 volunteers from approximately 100 communities raised over \$19.1 million to meet Jewish needs in Israel, around the world and in their own communities. That was a record for a mass appeal in peacetime.

"Our goal for Super Sunday '82" he went on "is to involve 150 communities and raise \$25 million. Many first-time communities have begun planning for it, still others have expressed interest and momentum is growing."

Among Super Sunday's campaign benefits, Dick indicated, is its effectiveness in reaching out to potential new volunteers and new givers

and in creating community-wide involvement. "Thousand of people who have not participated in past UJA campaigns will have the opportunity to make a significant contribution to a vital cause that is an important element in the lives of millions of Americans," he said. "Jewish need is the reason for Super Sunday. The vitality of today's Jewish community so vividly symbolized and expressed by Super Sunday, will determine the strength of the Jewish future."
