the Dead Sea; another item protesting Israel's scientific excavations in Jerusalem, and still another charging the Israelis with torturing Palestinians, etc. They have, moreover, made much ago about Israel's bombing of the Iraqi reactor, and to all these they have added still another proposal -- the establishment of a 'Palestinian' university, pro - PLO, of course, in Jerusalem. It is not difficult to guess what they have in mind with such a proposal.

All this brings us to the question of how the latest Saudi - Arabian 'peace' plan will fare here at the UN and what fate will befall the Camp David accords. More important is another question being asked by many in both the Jewish and non - Jewish worlds: now that Sadat is gone whither Egypt?

The Egyptian Ambassador to the UN appears to have given us the answer.

During the recent debate over Israel's bombing of the Iraqi atomic reactor -- at which Ambassador Jeane Kirkpatrick alone among all the delegations voted with Yehuda Z. Blum after she had strongly criticized the very debate on the item -- Abdel Meguid, Cairo's long - time spokesman here, not only joined all the other Arabs in condemning Israel but he also said something which may serve as a clue to Egypt's future intentions. He reemphasized an Egyptian delegation statement made last June:

"... Egypt has been affected by this act of aggression as much as all Arab countries and people have been. Egypt has been and will continue to be an organic part and parcel of the Arab nation. Our history is one, our present aspirations and our goals are one, and our common destiny is and always will be one. Not one person, Government or country, should be under the illusion that Egypt's national interests differ from those of the Arab people -- and I say that loud and clear. They are one and the same."

Meguid did add, however, that "Egypt as it has done in war will fulfill in peace all its historical tasks in safeguarding and enhancing the legitimate interests and aspirations of the Arab people. This can only be interpreted as meaning full support for the PLO and even of

the acceptance of the Saudi Arabian 'peace' plan calling for an independent PLO state in Samaria and Judea with Old Jerusalem as its capital, etc.

In a recent article, Abba Eban noted that "the Saudi text not only seeks to annul 242 by emptying it of those provisions that safeguard Israel's interests. It is also a body blow to the Camp David accords. Saudi Arabia has attacked Camp David by boycotting Anwar el-Sadat up and beyond the grave, by lavishly financing the PLO and other anti - Camp David forces and by insisting on restoring Soviet participation in the Middle East peace process..

In the light of the above -- another question: shall Israel withdraw from the final third portion of Sinai by April 1982? Still another question: has normalization proceeded as per the Camp David accords and does it not appear, therefore, that Egypt is violating these accords? Finally: Is there a real peace between Israel and Egypt?
