BEGIN BREAKS HIP, BUT CONDUCTS CABINET

JERUSALEM (WNS) Cabinet, -- Israel's meeting in a ward at Hospital Hadassah where Premier Menachem Begin underwent surgery Nov 26 for a broken hip joint, approved the departure to Washington of Defense Minister Ariel Sharon to discuss with Defense Secretary Caspar Weinberstrategic cooperation agreement between Israel and the U.S. but at the same time the more immediate problem facing the Begin government -- whether to accept European participation in the Multinational force to patrol Sinai after Israeli withdrawal -- was defereed until this month.

some Although ministers demanded more time to study the draft of the agreement on strategic cooperation, Sharon was disparched on his mission at the urging of Premier Begin Begin meanwhile was said by his doctors to be recovering from the operation as scheduled but however limited his Cabinet Cabinet meeting to 90 minutes.

The Cabinet meeting began only hoursafter Minister Foreign Vitzhak Shamir returned from a 15 hour visit to Washington and a marathen I and a half hours of talks with Secretary of State Alexander Haig. Shamir's purpose wis to convey 'Israel's objection to participation in the Multinational Force and Observers (MFO) by Britain France Italy and The Netherlands on terms that the Israelis consider a negation of the Camp David accords. It is widely believed that Shamir was summoned Washington by Haig when it appeared the Cabinet would reject the Europeans unless their they changed attitude. Shamir, inhistalks with Haig, stressed there was nolinkage between Israel's request for a broader strategic cooperation agreement and the issue of European participation in MFO. Haig for his part, stressed that inclusion of the European powers would enhance the international legitimacy of the Sinai peacekeeping force and the legitimacy of the Egyp-

tian - Israeli peace treaty and the Camp David accords. Shamir emphasized there was no problem between Israel and the U.S. over the MFO. The problem he said, was with the Europeans, The Europeans have included in their announcement of participation that they joined the MFO on the basis of the Venice Declaration of which calls for 1980 Palestine Liberation Organization association in any peace process for the Mideast. Begin in the morning before the Cabinet gathered around bedside. Cabinet Se-Naor cretary Arye said the Cabinet was not able to complete its deliberation on the MFO because of the doctoral 90 minute limit on the meeting. The meeting was reported to have been stormy. The differences arose over whether Sharon should delay his trip to Washington-Several ministers protested vigorously over what they thought was the undue haste with which they were required to examine and decide on the American proposals for strategic cooperation, of which a draft copy WJS forwarded to the Begin Cabinet, But Begin is reportedly determined to have the strategic cooperation agreement concluded as speedily as possible.

Begin is said consider it a major political achievement for Israel even though it does not contain all that Israel had hoped for. He regards it moreover, as a personal triumphachieved during his meeting with President Reagan in Washington September, and is said to feel that whatever is lacking now could be built into strategic cooperation once the agreement is in force.

One element Israel reluctantly agreed to forego is joint

Another improvefrom Israel's viewpoint wil' have the accord spell out an element of "reciprocity ' meaning that each side would help the other. not merely that Israel would cooperate with the U.S. against possible Soviet aggression in the Middle East. Some ministers were uncomfortable with emphasis the America draft placed on the anti - Soviet aims of the agreement and Sharon was instructed to try to broaden its scope.

Shamir's seven hour - plus meeting with Haig is believed to have set a record for a single day's diplomatic conference. But the fact that Shamir was forced to fly home to Israel on a Saturday drewfierce protests from the religious parties in Begin's coalition government. Interior Minister Yosef Burg of the National Religious Party said the Sabbath trip was "a blantant deviation from the declared

policy and attitude of the Begin govern-Menahem Poment. rush, a Knesset member of the Agudat Israel said his party would demand a commitment . that no similar Sabbath violation would occur in the future. Shamir said he was "sorry" his mission had forced him to flv on the Sabbath. But he said it had been most urgent for him to return home immediately to convey the U.S. position to Begin.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Likud Knesset member Moshe Arens was approved by the Cabinet as Israel's next Ambassador to the United States. The appointment will receive final ratification after its approval by the United States government. Israel's present Ambassador to the U.S. is Ephraim Evron. Arens' replacement in the Knesset will be Michael Kleiner of the Herut faction. Kleiner is a former chairman of the 1el Aviv University's student union and presently the director general of the World Zionist Organization's education and culture department.

BRAZIL RABBI DISPUTES CLAIM


