

COURT RULING IS IMPORTANT

TRENTON, N. Y. -- The seven member State Supreme Court ruled unanimously that a ban on extra-curricular activities by a public school board on Jewish and Christian Sabbaths, to accommodate the religious needs of students was not an unconstitutional accommodation of religion.

The court affirmed, without opinion, an earlier ruling of a three-judge panel of the State Appellate Division which had upheld as constitutional such a ban by a Teaneck high school. The Teaneck Board of Education adopted on March 9, 1977, a policy which banned scheduling of extra-curricular student activities on Friday nights, Saturdays or Sunday mornings.

The board said the intent of the policy was to eliminate discriminatory practices in its public schools, among which it included the denial of opportunity to Sabbath-observing students to participate in extra-curricular activities on those days.

The policy, described as unprecedented in the United States

by the National Jewish Commission on Law and Public Affairs (COLPA), was challenged in November, 1978, by the Playcrafters a Teaneck high school drama

class, when they learned that their play "Don't Drink the Water," could not be performed, as originally scheduled on Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings during the fall semester of the 1978-79 school year.

VIENNA (WNS) -- Palestinian terrorists compiled a "hit list" of 60 targets in Austria, mostly Jewish or linked to Israel, the daily Kurier reported. According to

Kurier said the list had been circulated among various extremist Palestinian groups but gave no source for that information.
