representative of Waldheim on the situation in Afghanistan.

Javier Perez de Cuellar was born in Lima, Peru, on 19 January 1920. He is married to the former Marcela Temple. They have two children.

When on 15 December the General Assembly unanimously approved his election as recommended by the Security Council after this body had failed to elect either Waldheim or Salim Salim following 16 hectic balloting, de Cuellar (pronounced de Quellar), in his acceptance speech, made some interesting remarks revealing his character. He stated, among other things that he has "a clear and also a sober and positive idea of the responsibility thrust upon me by the decision of the Assembly. Over the past 10 years," he added, "I have been connected with the UN almost without a break. I was tangibly involved in the political dramas both in the Security Council... and later in the Secretariat on delicate missions to a number of countries."

"Despite the universal character of the function I shall be taking over as Secretary-General of all the United Nations," he continued to explain before a most attentive and also inquisitive assembly of delegates. "I am Peruvian, and I cannot and should not disregard the fact that I come from a developing country a country, which, furthermore, I have represented as a diplomat almost the whole of my life. He then went on to assure the world organization that his "only ambition will be to serve the higher interests of the international community and to work for the realization of the ideals and aspirations that have been placed in our Organization. I will do everything in my power to ensure scrupulous respect for the purposes and principles of the Charter. I will tackle all the problems with an open mind and I will act according to my conscience on the basis of right and justice."

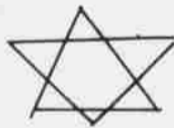
He then said that he "was sorry" that he could not "speak Arabic, Chinese or Russian and thus better communicate my thoughts to the distinguished representatives whose languages these are."

How our new Peruvian Secretary - General will fare as the troublesome year of 1982 breaks upon a world beset with crises as reflected here remains to be seen. One thing is certain, as we stated in the beginning, "he will infuse a new spirit into this headquarters."
