accomplishing any constructive purpose."

She continued in her strong criticism; "We oppose the use of the UN involved here because this body was and is meant to be devoted to build-ing peace and security, and this draft resolution seeks neither. Instead it uses this body as an instrument to deepen divisions and exacerbate conflicts. We oppose this draft resolution because, like any other cynical use of power, it will leave this body weaker than it already is, less fit to achieve its noble aims...."

Referring to the intrasigence of the Syrian regime, she declared that "there is no one in this hall who does not know which party has refused to negotiate peace or even to accept resolution 242. Yet the resolution before us to-day and the speeches we have heard take no account of this reality...'

She made it plain to everyone present that the real culprit in this whole Golan affair is Syria's Assad. She did not mince any words. She came right out with it.

What a different picture we have of Caspar Weinberger! What a pitiful role he played in Riyad and Amman! Fahd and Hussein surely must have laughed behind his back. May the U.S. never sink so low again! Repair your fences, Washington! Take heed!

Last year the Austrian Resistance Movement mailed a leaflet to all households in Mayrhofen, in which Hausberger was denounced for his Nazi past. Now the mayor has sued the organization for libel. The District Attorney contends that there is not sufficient evidence against Hausberger.
