

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The latest developments in the field of medical technology will be unveiled at Medax '82, Israel's second international medical exhibition, May 23 - 26 in Jerusalem. Some 300 local and foreign manufacturers and distributors of medical apparatus, aids and drugs will display their most recent innovations.

BONN (WNS) -- The city of Hamburg announced plans to erect a memorial to the poet Heinrich Heine to replace the one destroyed by the Nazis because of Heine's Jewish origin. The project was announced less than a month after the University of Dusseldorf, the city where Heine was born, voted to reject proposals to re-name the university after Heine. Hamburg commissioned sculptor Waldeman Otto of Bremen to build the new Heine memorial modeled on the old one. It will be erected in front of the Hamburg City Hall and is expected to be officially dedicated in May.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Argentina's Ambassador to the United States, Esteban Takacs, conveyed to the World Jewish Congress the official condemnation of his government of the desecration of the Jewish cemetery at Mar del Plata, Argentina's main seaside resort. The main cemetery of the Jewish community of Mar del Plata, situated some 250 miles south of Buenos Aires, was vandalized on the evening of February 25. Reportedly, the incident involved the daubing of swastikas in addition to three headstones that were overturned.


WASHINGTON (WNS) -- The House, by a unanimous 387 - 0 vote adopted a resolution calling on the Soviet Union to allow Jews to emigrate and to practice their religion freely and also called for the end of "indiscriminate arrests and trials of Jewish activists" and an end to the "assaults on Jewish self study groups," it was reported.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The World Jewish Congress reported that Mikis Theodorakis, the well-known composer of the scores for the films "Zorba the Greek" and "Z," has written a "Palestinian national anthem," produced at the request of Palestine Liberation Organization leader Yasir Arafat. The report of this development originates from a monitored broadcast of "Tunis Afrique Presse" (TAP). According to the report, Theodorakis arrived in Beirut March 1 to present his finished work.

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. (WNS) -- The Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith praised Gov. Bob Graham and the Florida state legislature for enacting a law designed to bar paramilitary training camps run by the Ku Klux Klan and other extremist groups. The law, signed here and based on a "model" bill introduced by the ADL, imposes a maximum sentence of five years and a \$5,000 fine on anyone convicted of violating its provisions, and bars anyone from training persons in acts of violence intended to provoke civil disturbance in the United States.
