MORE ARMS TO SAUDIS

WASH. (WNS) -- The Defense Department announced here that it was planning a new \$350 million arms package sale to Saudi Arabia which includes 10 F-5E tactical reconnaissance aircraft and five F-5E jet fighters. Official notification of the sale was given to Congress. According to the Pentagon, the package will also contain specialized

purpose cameras, specialized support equipment and spare parts to cover needs of the next three years. The announcement indicated that the reconnaissance and fighter aircraft, manufactured by the California based Northrop Corp., are intended mainly as replacements for the Saudis aging fleet of 100 F-5Es.

banon," the Defense Minister said. "We don't have intentions to invade Lebanon or attack Lebanon. Neither do we have any intention to annex any part of Lebanon." He disclosed that Israel has given a clear commitment not to move into Lebanon unless there is "clear provocation" by the PLO there. Asked what would constitute a provocation, he replied, "When Jews in Israel are killed."

Apparently reacting to Sharon's remarks, the PLO operated Voice of Palestine Radio in Beirut warned that PLO forces and their allies would strike deep into Israel territory if Israeli leaders persisted in making "provocative statements."

Shamir's statement to Habib that "if we are not attacked, we will not attack," received an equivocal interpretation from Zbigniew Brzezinski who was National Security Advisor in the Carter Administration. Appearing on the same program that broadcast the satellite interview with Sharon from Jerusalem, Brzezinski said he believed that Sharon was "trying to tell us Israel prefers not to go in (to Lebanon) but that they will go in." He called this an "ominous development" which was part of what is described as a "general determination" in the Middle East.

While the Israeli - Lebanese border remained calm, both sides continued to wage propaganda warfare of which Israel found itself on the short side. The Prime Minister's Office flatly denied a Newsweek Magazine report that the Reagan Administration had warned Israel not to create a situation which would justify an Israeli attack on south Lebanon. According to Newsweek, the U.S. feared the Israelis would

allow Palestinian terrorists to infiltrate their territory and seize on that as a pretext to attack. The Prime Minister's Office told Newsweek that Israel does not act "cunningly" but states its position clearly and forthrightly.

The Foreign Ministry again had to issue another denial, this time in connection with media reports in the United States that Habib had conveyed a warning from Washington to Begin not to take any military action in Lebanon. "No warning whatever" was received, a Foreign Ministry spokesman said.

Nevertheless, observers in Jerusalem were speculating what prompted U.S. sources to leak stories of an alleged warning in the first place. Israel Television's military commentator suggested that the leaks were intended to demonstrate to the moderate Arab states that the U.S. alone -- not the Soviet Union -- has the ability to restrain Israel. Highly placed Israeli sources said there was nothing restraining Israel inasmuch as Israel has stated repeatedly that it plans no military action in Lebanon unless provoked.

Meanwhile, in another development, Shamir called on "France and the West" to help Lebanon free itself from the Shackles of occupation by Syria and the PLO. Shamir, addressing French paratroopers, said the Lebanese want to reassert their independence but the presence in their country of 30,000 Syrian troops and 20,000 PLO terrorists effectively prevents this.

BONN (WNS) -- Interior Minister Gerhart Baum has warned the Bundestag that the Palestine Liberation Organization is escalating its terrorist activities in West Germany and other parts of Europe and cited several recent cases of cooperation between the PLO and German terrorist groups.

FRANCE DENIES ARMS SALE

PARIS (WNS) -- An official communique released by the French Foreign Ministry denied that the sale of French arms to Israel was discussed during President Francois Mitterrand's recent visit to Israel. The communique said the subject "was not discussed at any moment" during the Mitterrand visit. The communique added: "There is no reason for this subject to be raised at the forthcoming session of the Franco-Israeli economic mission" which is to meet April 29 in Paris.

French papers quoted Israeli Foreign Minister Yitzhak Shamir as saying the commission will deal with this issue.
