Christians and Jews must continue to exchange ideas "indepth on the basis their own identities." This message was conveyed by Pope John Paul II in an address to 40 Church and laymen from 15 countries, including Israel, who participated in three and a half day meeting designed to advance the ongoing Christian - Jewish dialogue and assess the progress made since it was initiated at the Second Ecumenical Council in 1965. The convocation was held at the Varican.

The Pope's remarks affirmed the abandonment of any and all attempts to convert convert the Jews the Church's "special relationship" with Jews exempts them from being subjected to the Gospel commandment to "evangelize" the world, the Pontiff noted. While this is firmly based on declarations made in the past, from the "Nostra Aetate" (In Our Time) promulgated at Vati-can II to the "Catholic Guildlines" 1978, this convocation marked the first time the Pope personally addressed the delicate issue at an international gathering. He spoke not only to Roman Catholics but to representatives of the Orthodox churches, the Anglican Communion, the World Lutheran Federation and the World Council of Churches who attended the meet-
