This week Secret Witness will pay \$1,000 cash reward for information leading to the arrest and indictment of the person or persons that have committed the following crimes:

Starting on February 19, 1982, two or three white male adults have been committing numerous residential armed robberies. In the majority of the instances, one of the persons has knocked on the victim's door and requested entrance to the residence in order to use the telephone. After gaining entry, suspect displays a handgun and is joined by the second suspect in the residence. At this point the victims are robbed. In most cases tied up. In some cases the victims vehicle has also been stolen. All of these robberies are occurring in the southeast portion of Las Vegas and predominately in apartment type buildings.

The suspects are described as follows:  
White male adult, 25 - 27 years, 6'1", med. build, sandy blond hair, (wavy collar length hair - uncombed), sandy blond moustache, lt. colored eyes.

White male adult, 19 - 21 yrs., 6'1", 180 lbs, dk. brn-blk hair (Collar length-styled-parted in middle), dk. colored eyes.

White male adult, 30 years, 6'2", 180/190 medium build, lt. brn. hair, uncombed, med. lgth., mustache, lt. color eyes. (Looked like construction worker).

Anyone that may have information pertaining to any of the crimes mentioned is asked to call the Secret Witness Hot Line, 386-3213. Callers do not have to reveal their identities in giving the information or collecting the \$1,000 cash reward.

Secret Witness will also pay cash rewards on other major crimes or crimes that are being planned.
