## BAT MITZVAH AT TEMPLE BETH SHOLOM

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- There was no formal flag lowering or hand over ceremonies, the Israel army simply left the final portion of the Sinai on April 25 as scheduled, exactly three years after signing the peace treaty with Egypt and the Camp David accords. It was also just two months under 15 years since capturing the area in the Six-Day-War of 1967. The army's departure was in a demonstration of the sacrifices Israel was making for the sake of peace

with its largest Arab neighbor.

Apart from the brief 10 - minute ceremony at Ophira at which the Israeli Air Force lowered the flag and the last helicopter left the ground on its way back to Israel at 7:30 in the morning, the only timetable for the steps in the total evacuation was that "the last man should be out of the area and back across the old-new border by noon," an army spokesman solemnly declared, A multinational peace keeping force will now patrol the area.

Within minutes of the last Israeli soldier leaving Ophira, Egyptian officials were putting up new signs at the nearby airfield, saying in Arabaic and English: "Sharm-e-Sheikh" -its old name prior to its Israeli take-over years ago. By mid - afternoon Egyptian flags were raised at the three border crossing point of Taba near Eilar, the future of which
