

U.S. VETOES ANTI-ISRAEL RESOLUTION

UNITED NATIONS (WNS) -- An Arab sponsored resolution in the Security Council strongly condemning the shooting on the Temple Mount in Jerusalem was vetoed by the United States. The vote was 14 - 1 in favor of the draft which was initiated by Jordan and Morocco. It was the culmination of a seven - day long acrimonious debate on the "situation in the occupied Arab territories" which was precipitated by the shooting spree in which two Arabs were killed and 30 persons were wounded.

U.S. Ambassador Jeane Kirkpatrick explained after the vote that the U.S. opposed the resolution because it implied that "the responsibility for this terrible event lies not with the individual responsible for the incident but with the Israeli authorities who have unequivocally denounced the act."

She added: "Thus, as much as we condemn the act of violence that occasioned this debate of the Security Council, we must oppose this resolution, which, in our view, would make new acts of violence more, not less, likely to take place in the future."

Israel's Ambassador Yehuda Blum, speaking before the vote, said the resolution "seeks to associate Israel with the crime of a single

individual acting on his own." He was referring to the American - born Israel army soldier who opened fire on Moslem worshippers. The suspect, Allan Harry Goodman, originally from Baltimore, has been arraigned for the crime.

The draft resolution declared that the Security Council "condemns in the strongest terms these appalling acts of sacrilege" and called on "Israel, the occupying power, to observe and apply scrupulously the provisions of the Fourth Geneva Convention and the principles of international law governing military occupation and to refrain from causing any hindrance to the discharge of the established functions of the Higher Islamic Council in Jerusalem."

It deplored "any act or encouragement or profanation" of holy places and shrines in Jerusalem "as tending to disturb world peace." The resolution also called on the Secretary General to keep the Security Council "fully informed on the implementation of this resolution."

ATTACK INTENDED FOR TRANSIT CAMPS

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Austria's Interior Minister has told the World Jewish Congress that the Palestinian terrorists being held for the attack on Vienna's main synagogue last August have admitted under interrogation that the transit for Soviet Jewish emigrants in Vienna was originally an intended target.

Minister Erwin

Lanc, who oversees Austria's internal security and police forces, met with leadership of WJC American section, accepting the invitation of its Chairman, Rabbi Arthur Schneier, for a private two - hour meeting April 19. The meeting took place at the Park East Synagogue, whose spiritual leader is Schneier. The talks focused on

a wide range of issues of mutual concern relating to the Soviet Jewry question, international terrorism, and Austrian foreign policy.

Lanc reported on intensified measures being taken by the Austrian authorities to insure the security of the transit camp of Soviet Jewish emigrants in Vienna. He noted in this connection that prior to the attack on the Vienna synagogue, the Palestinian terrorists had had the camp under lengthy scrutiny but had abandoned their planned attack against it.

LABOR MINISTER INTENDS TO RESIGN

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Aharon Abu-Hatzeira, Israel's Minister of Labor, Welfare and Absorption said that he intends to resign from the Cabinet but will remain in the Knesset pending the outcome of his appeal to the Supreme Court against his conviction on three counts of larceny, fraud and breach of trust.

their military ID cards which had been withdrawn. Burg, a National Religious Party member of the Knesset, said Cohen's allegations were "vicious," based on false information. He said Cohen's past as Supreme Court Justice did not give him the right to make such charges.

The IDF reacted sharply to the charges. It issued a statement totally rejecting the allegations. An Army spokesman said the IDF has been acting "wholly in accordance with the law, with patience, tolerance and considerable restraint." The spokesman said the army resorted to force only in cases where it encountered violence.

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN PEOPLE DIE?

Children experience death in many ways. When a pet dies, or perhaps a relative dies it's important to answer the child's questions directly and honestly, and not to say that the person went away or went to sleep. It's helpful to tell the child that death is natural and that when we die our bodies don't feel anything. A child should be allowed to go to the funeral home, but never forced.
