

NURSES DAY AT VALLEY HOSPITAL

To pay tribute to all of the hospital's dedicated nursing personnel, Valley Hospital is celebrating National Nurses' Day on May 6. Theme for this celebration is "Nurses Are Great!"

As Director of Nursing at Valley Hospital, Sydney Wooten, RN, is in charge of nearly 300 nurses from the Pediatric Unit to ICU-CCU. "I would like to thank and extend to the nursing staff my appreciation for their promoting and maintaining a professional approach and attitude that generates respect and cooperation among fellow workers in achieving our goal of quality patient care."

Wooten explained that the Nursing De-

In addition to the 10 nursing units, Valley Hospital also has specialized nursing units including Staff Development, Flight For Life, the Emergency Department, Institute of Psychiatry and Surgical Services.

Throughout Nurses' Day, the more than 400 registered nurses, LPNs, nursing assistants and nursing personnel techs will be feted to special receptions and free meals in the hospital cafeteria. Each nurse will receive a white carnation as a symbol of their faithful service to both the patient and the hospital.
