This week Secret Witness will pay \$1,000 cash reward for information leading to the arrest and indictment of the person or persons that have committed the following crimes:

Secret Witness will pay a \$1,000 cash reward to anyone that has information which will lead to the arrest and indictment of the person or persons who are responsible for the kidnap and murder of JAMEY WALKER. The family of JAMEY is also offering a sizeable reward for the information.

ARSON: (Up to \$1,000 Cash Reward).
On March 13, 1982, the Montessori Academy, at 6000 West Oakey Boulevard, had two of their vehicles set on fire, one being a Ford Van; the other a 33 passenger bus.

Again, on April 2, 1982, a fire was set in a building at 2214 North Pecos Road, also belonging to Montessori Academy. And, on April 10th, another fire was set in a trailer also belonging to Montessori Academy, 6000 West Oakey Boulevard.
