#### JEWS, CHRISTIANS BLAST PRAYER AMENDMENT

A broad representation of Jewish orfoined ganizations with Christian groups and the American Civil Liberties Union to denounce President Reagan's proposal for a Constitutional amendment to permit voluntary prayers in the public schools. Opponents of the proposal cited, at a conference press here, the need to keep intact the constitutional separation of and state. church that They argued prayers cannot be voluntary when they are mandated by a school system because a child opposed to participation would be subject to criticism from schoolmates or compelled by peer pressures to join in whatever ceremony was held.

Marc Pearl, Washington representative of the American Jewish Congress, said at the Capitol Hill press conference that the community, Jewish "in particular, 18 acutely aware of government-imposed religion," adding that it was for that reason "that many of ancestors fled from

Europe. The press conference met an hour after President Reagan, in a national prayer day ceremony held in the White House Rose Garden, announced his support for a Constitutional amendment to permit voluntary prayer in public schools. However, he gave no details of the bill his Administration plans to submit to the Congress. He told some 100 religious leaders at the ceremony that "no one will ever convince me that a moment of voluntary prayer will harm a child or threaten a school or state but I think it can strengthen our faith in who alone Creator

has the power to bless America,"

Speakers at the conference press also included Gary Ross of the Seventh Day Adventists; Maryh Cooper of the National Council Churches: John Baker general counsel of the Baptist Joint Committee on Public Affairs: Charles Bergstrom of the Lutheran Council: David Landau, legislative ACLU counsel; Jane Harvey of the United Methodist Church: and the Rev. R. G. Puckett, executive director of Americans United for Separation Church and State.

The Jewish organizations which signed the statement opposing the proposed amendment were the American Jewish Con-National gress: the

Jewish Community Relations Advisory Council: the Synagogue Council of America; and the Na-tional Coalition for Public Education and Religious Liberty (PEARL). Representatives of the National Council of Jewish Women (NCJW) and B'nai B'rith Women arrended the press conference. Both Dorothy Binstock, B'nai B'rith Women president, and Shirley Leviton, NCJW president, issued statements criticizing President Reagan for the amendment proposal.

## W. GERMANY STOPS TANK SALES

(WNS) BONN Chancellor Helmut Schmidt has dropped plans to sell Saudi West Ger-Arabia many's most advanced tank, the Leopard II, but has not excluded the sale of other sophisticated arms to the Saudis, according to a report in the daily Die Welt. The newspaper said Schmidt changed his mind on the tank sale because of serious problems political within his ruling Democratic Social Party. (SPD).

The government recently adopted new guidelines for the sale ahroad. of arms They removed the long self - imposed ban against weapons sales to countries in areas of tension, such as the Middle East. Future decisions on arms exports by West will be Germany made on the basis of the country's "vital" political and security interests.

It is widely believed that the government is prepared

to examine future Saudi requests for armored vehicles of various ttypes including some equipped with antiaircraft systems.

#### GOODMAN INDICTED FOR TEMPLE SHOOTING

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The Jerusalem District Court ordered that Allan Harry Goodman, accused of opening fire at the Temple Mount last month, during which two Arabs were killed and 30 people were wounded, be held for an additional 15 days.

Goodman was originally ordered held for 15 days pending his trial when he was arraigned at a court here shortly after the incident. Goodman, a 38 - year - old bachelor from Baltimore, Md., who immigrated to Israel 14 months ago, was indicted on one count of murder five counts of attempted murder.

The charge sheet said he intended to "liberate" the Temple Mount.


