

ISRAEL DENIES ARMS SALE TO ARGENTINA

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Israel has denied that an Ecuadorian cargo aircraft detained at Kennedy Airport in New York after a flight from Tel Aviv was carrying Israeli arms to Argentina. The Foreign Ministry informed the British Embassy here that there was no truth to reports that Israel is sending arms to Argentina.

reports from the U.S. some Israeli nationals were among the crew of the Ecuadorian Boeing 707 who were being questioned by State Department officials. The plane reportedly was carrying high impact bombs manufactured in Israel. According to the cargo manifest, the plane's destination was Quito, Ecuador. The U.S. Customs Department in Washington said that an

investigation was in progress to determine whether the shipment was legal and properly licensed.

American press reports quoted a State Department official as saying it was "highly speculative" that the cargo was destined for Argentina. U.S. officials became suspicious that the arms were for Argentina because they were not entered on the bill of lading. Israeli officials here conceded that the plane took off from Ben Gurion airport and made a refueling

stop at Shannon, Ireland. They refused to say what cargo it carried. Israel has a contract to service and maintain Ecuadorian planes.

Defense Minister Ariel Sharon, in New York to address a meeting of the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations as part of his visit to the United States, said that Ecuadorian cargo aircraft was carrying arms for Ecuador. He said that Israel sold arms to Ecuador with "the approval and moral support" of the United States government. He said that Israel has no intention of getting involved in the British - Argentina dispute over the Falkland Islands.

JEWIS WANTS NO NUKES

NEW YORK (WNS) -- An increasing number of Jewish representatives are calling for a halt to the nuclear arms race through a freeze on nuclear weapons by the United States and the Soviet Union.

At a recent meeting of the board of directors of the Jewish Community Relations Council of Greater Philadelphia, a resolution was adopted which stated: "No issue threatens our existence as Jews, Americans and world citizens than the specter of nuclear warfare. For the Jewish community... history teacher us that man is capable of perpetrating unspeakable acts and further, that silence in the face of inhumanity is equivalent to complicity in the injustice." In a related action, more than 100 religious and secular


Jewish leaders including dozens of rabbis, three members of Congress, four Nobel Prize winners and leaders of Jewish organizations have signed a "Shalom Aleichem" statement urging all American Jews to address the issue of thermonuclear world disaster and the need for controlling and reversing the arms race. The statement was initiated by the editorial board of Menorah, a monthly journal "of Jewish renewal" published in Washington, D.C. and edited by Arthur Waskow.

The first Jewish religious conference in New York City was held to deal with the problem of "the threat of nuclear war." It was sponsored by 10 Reform Jewish Organization of New York and was convened at the Stephen Wise Free Synagogue.
