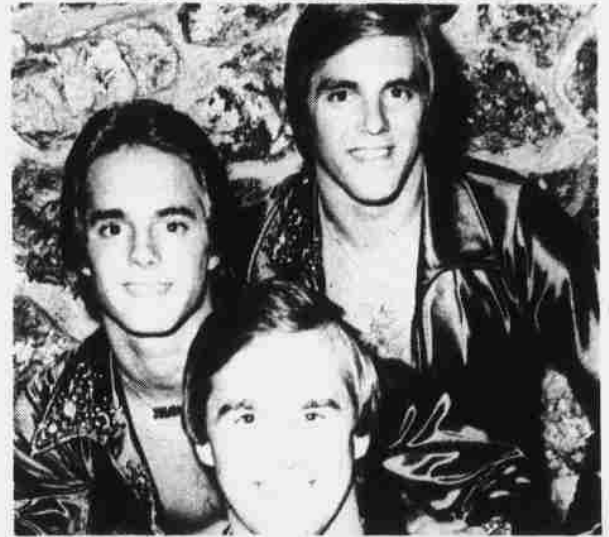
LANDMARK MARKS "FESTIVAL OF ICE"
