**RABBI TANENBAUM RAPS CHURCH GROUP**

NASHVILLE, Tenn. (WNS) -- A section of a Middle East resolution adopted by the Governing Board of the National Council of Churches called upon the United States Government to "undertake an open dialogue with the PLO" without requiring the PLO to repudiate its announced aims for the violent destruction of Israel has been strongly criticized by the American Jewish Committee. The AJC reaction was issued here by Rabbi Marc Tanenbaum, AJC's National interreligious affairs director, and Rabbi A. James Dubin, assistant director and AJC representative to the NCC Governing Board as an official fraternal observer.

While acknowledging that the NCC resolution contains a number of positive affirmations about Israel and Egypt and the Camp David peace process, the two AJC spokesmen deplored the fact that "the latest resolution fails to urge two preconditions for any governmental dialogue with the PLO... the PLO's recognizing Israel's right to exist... and the cessation of all hostile acts carried out against Israel. This resolution can only lend legitimacy to the PLO, the pivotal catalyst for international terrorism -- hardly a moral position expected from a major Chris-

**BEGIN SURVIVES NO-CONFIDENCE VOTE**

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Premier Menachem Begin's Likud-led coalition government narrowly retained its mandate when the Knesset voted 58-57 to defeat a Labor sponsored motion of no-confidence. In the immediate aftermath of the stormy debate in the Knesset, the prospect of early elections, possibly in November, heightened.

Begin's regime was saved by three abstentions: one by Hanan Porat of the ultra-nationalist Te-hiya faction whose two other Knesset members, Geula Cohen and Yuval Neeman, voted with Labor; and the others by the two member Telem faction. Two Knesset members were absent.

In the long bitter Knesset debate which preceded the vote, the economic issues on which the no-confidence motion was based were all but forgotten. Likud instead concentrated its fire on MKs Amnon Lin and Yitzhak Peretz whose announced defection from Likud just a day earlier put the government in jeopardy and made the Labor alignment the largest single parliamentary faction.
