*Billy Graham's  
 Mission to Moscow*

Dr. Billy Graham's recent mission to Moscow was more than a series of blunders. There can be no question that Dr. Graham's comments about the supposed freedom of religion in Russia were harmful. But there were aspects of his trip that were constructive. These should not be lost in the brouhaha that has surrounded his visit.

Billy Graham had a number of lengthy meetings with key Politburo officials. During these unpublicized conversations, Billy Graham told me that he communicated forcefully to Kremlin authorities the deep concern of the American people over religious repression of Jews and Christians in Russia. He also told the Politburo officials that if they want improved relations with America that they had better change their policies and practices toward all Christian and Jewish believers.

Then, Dr. Graham made a precondition of his going to Russia that he would meet with Jewish as well as Christian leaders. Well, he did meet with Moscow's chief rabbi and Jewish leaders, but it was mainly a ceremonial session.

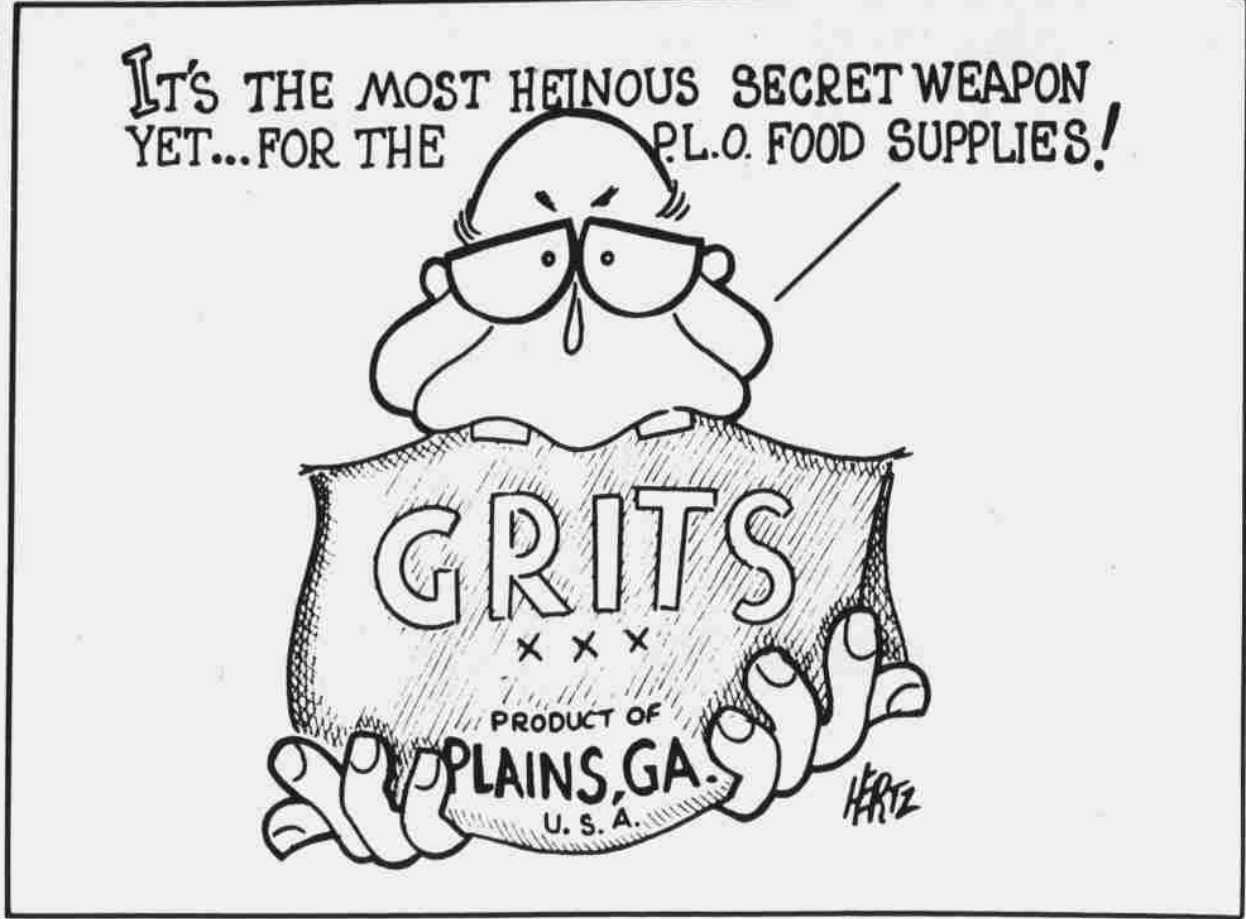
Finally, Dr. Graham may have served the cause of human rights despite himself. The outcry against his statements by Christians and Jews in many parts of the world certainly must have made clear to the Kremlin that try as they may to manipulate Billy Graham, they failed to fool anybody. **Behind The Scenes**

At The United Nations

*Argentina and PLO*

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- The Argentine Government has broken up a terrorist network directed and trained by the PLO, according to an Argentine diplomat who, in an interview with this writer last week at the Security Council once again began to debate the ongoing Falkland-Malvinas-Isles crisis, cited General Christino Nicolaide, commander-in-chief of the Third Division of the Argentine army, as having accused Yasir Arafat's PLO as being behind the terrorists.

That the PLO has penetrated all through Latin America as elsewhere around the globe is well-known to the so-called 'respectable' Members of the UN, among them Bruno Kreisky's Austria, India, Pakistan, etc. including, of course, the USSR and its satellites who use Arafat's gangsters as 'agents.' Their continuous murders, the assassinations are, of course, also well-known to them.

Yet in the face of these horrifying facts, they do not hesitate to lend their full support to this Beirut-headquartered 'Murder, Inc.' They constitute a somewhat dwindling majority whenever a vote is tabled either in the Security Council or the General Assembly condemning Israel on the basis of Soviet-Arab-instigated fallacious charges.

It goes without saying therefore that these so-called 'respectable' states cannot claim exemption from being accessories to these PLO-committed murders of innocent men, women and children. They must bear some responsibility. Whatever their relations with the West or with Israel, they stand as guilty as the radical Libyans and the so-called 'moderate' Saudis and the others who finance Arafat and his international network of murderers.

And what about the United States which has found it expedient to curry the favor of the Saudis and the Jordanians by fortifying them with sophisticated lethal weapons to be used against whom? Is Washington blind to the connection that links these 'respectable' states with the assassins? There appears to be but one single voice within the Administration crying out against

this connection -- that of Jeane Kirkpatrick. With the support of Congress, may that voice prevail.

True, the Reagan Administration, following the policy of previous Administrations, has refused to recognize the PLO until -- mark well -- until the PLO recognizes Israel's existence -- as if Israel needs to be recognized. The nation is there. Jerusalem needs no favors. But there have been U.S. flirtations with Arafat, even some prodding on the part of some that he come out in the open and say he recognizes Israel as a fact. America ought to know better. This is like forcing a person to love another when no love exists.

How blind can the Administration be! Reagan and his aides must wake up to the fact that the PLO is serving the Communist cause around the globe, that Arafat is paying a price for Moscow's military support -- that of serving anti-Americanism in all continents; and for Saudi's financing, a pledge to lead a jihad unto Israel's annihilation. Reagan should wake up to the peril which the PLO poses for America's security not only locally but around the globe.

Reagan and his aides must realize by now that the kidnapping of U.S. General James L. Dozier had its origin in Beirut. The leader of the Red Brigade, Antonio Sevasta, who was convicted of the kidnapping, revealed that the PLO was behind the Brigade which had been fed with weapons and explosives smuggled into Italy from Lebanon by Arafat's 'Murder, Inc.'

It is now also clear to the world that Arafat had bolstered Khomeini and that his PLO had been implicated in the kidnapping of the American hostages. Time and again Arafat has let it be known that he will do everything in his power to work against American interests everywhere in the world.

Washington has as yet to find a proper method of counteracting the PLO infiltrations here at the UN and elsewhere. We have let the PLO make a ruin of Lebanon and more than once cried 'violence' when Israel sought to wipe out the festering nest of vipers.

We have let the PLO develop into a terrifying octopus whose twelve tendrils zero themselves into many fronts emanating from the ugly head Al-Asifah commanded by Arafat. There is the "Popular Front of the Liberation of Palestine," "The Democratic Front," the "Popular Front," "Black June," "Eagles of the Revolution," and the "Organization of May 15;" also "The Popular Struggle Front."

Argentina is to be commended for having broken up its network of PLO terrorists. May other nations take note.
