

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Leon Dulzin, chairman of the World Zionist Organization and Jewish Agency Executive, made a fervent appeal to world Jewry to support the special campaign launched by the Jewish Agency here to raise additional funds needed by Israel in the wake of the war in Lebanon to increase welfare, education, housing, and health services. In a message beamed to Jewish communities overseas and published in large advertisements in its local press, Dulzin urged aliya and stressed that what Israel's armed forces achieved in Lebanon strengthened its security of not only Israel but of Jews all over the world.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The government and the Jewish Agency are planning a special fund raising campaign abroad in the wake of the "Peace for Galilee" military operation in Lebanon, it was disclosed by Cabinet Secretary Dan Meridor following a Cabinet meeting.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- A team of 30 Israel Bond leaders from 24 communities overseas who came to Israel to study the impact of the war in Lebanon on Israel's economy concluded their 48 hour stay on July 1 by renewing their pledge to Premier Menachem Begin to raise an additional \$100 million between now and September so that Israel's economic development will not suffer.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- With Israel in a partially mobilized state during the "Shalom Galilee" action in Lebanon, all ORT schools are functioning normally in Israel despite the call-up of several hundred teachers, directors and staff, according to Sidney Leiwant, president of American ORT.

PROVIDING A HELPING HAND

One of the greatest misfortunes of war is the tragic suffering of innocent civilians caught in the middle. In this particular instance, the Israeli operation to push Palestinian terrorists beyond artillery range of its northern settlements, it is the Lebanese people that have been caught in the web of war. They have been plagued over the years by the presence of the PLO who carefully placed a large portion of their military infrastructure in civilian population centers. An example of this is the huge cache of arms that was captured in an underground bunker beneath an elementary school in the coastal town of Tyre.

The PLO's realization of Israeli uneasiness to attack civilian centers maintained that organization's ability to store, stockpile and eventually use these arms against innocent Israeli civilians who reside in the northern Galilee. But while the Israeli population supports the military action against Palestinian terrorists, called, "Peace for Galilee," they have been disturbed at the scenes of the wreckage and de-

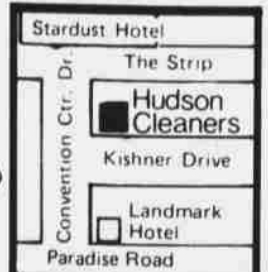
