NEW YORK -- Reform Rabbis deferred for further study a statement that would have accepted the children of a mixed marriage as Jewish if either the father or mother is a Jew. The Patrilineal statement that was presented for action said "Where only one of the parents is Jewish, the Jewishness of a child is derivable from the Jewish parent and is expressed by participation in Jewish life." The Rabbis were mixed in opinion.

Rather there was sorrow in its homes at the cost exacted. And when the record is known, it will be shown that the media's picture of the Israeli army is an evil canard that falsely presented

it to the world. The truth is very different for the people of Israel have never

forgotten the teachings of their Prophets and remain steadfast in their dedi-

cation to human dignity and to democracy's and Judaism's ethical ideals, including a profound concern for the sanctity of life.

There is no joy in Israeli hearts at the havoc of war caused by the need to safeguard their rocket-prone northern com-

munities and to end the terrorist PLO sway over Lebanon."

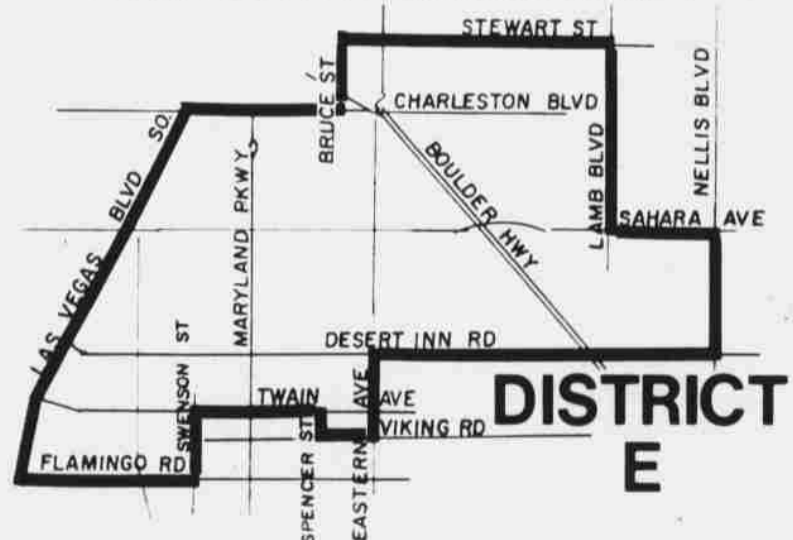
