solution of the towns in southern Lebanon. Accordingly, the people of Israel, who have felt destruction and devastation themselves, have responded enthusiastically to a project for home hospitality for south Lebanese mothers and children rendered homeless by the war. Thousands of Israeli families from all sections of the populace have responded to the call from Pioneer Women/Na'amat, with the help of Israel radio and the Yediot Achronot newspaper. The project calls for an Israeli family to host a Lebanese mother and infant child in their homes for up to one month. Pioneer Women/Na'amat is handling the logistics in coordination with the police and the army.

At the same time a convoy of 20 Magen David Adom ambulances carrying doctors, paramedics and other volunteers, crossed into south Lebanon to extend medical aid. Auxiliary vehicles carried blankets, clothing and ice cream for the children. The convoy was warmly greeted and is scheduled to stay for some two weeks time. In addition, the Israeli Health Ministry has earmarked \$30 thousand in immediate aid for the 15 - odd private hospitals in Sidon and Tyre. And there are still other relief operations underway.

The Israelis know the agony, devastation and suffering of war. But with the elimination of the PLO from southern Lebanon and an increase in aid to help the recovery, both the people of Lebanon and Israel will benefit in the long run.

Buchanan Files For Reelection

James "Bucky" Buchanan filed recently as a candidate for reelection to the University of Nevada Board of Regents, District D.

Mr. Buchanan has been on the Board of Regents since 1972 and is filing for a six year term as a University Regent.

Buchanan is 47, the father of four children and is filing for reelection based upon his accomplishments for the University and Community College Systems in Clark County.

The projects Mr. Buchanan has undertaken during his ten years on the Board of Regents include the Community College in Henderson, which services the Boulder City, Henderson, Green Valley and surrounding areas. Mr. Buchanan, further, directed the placement of the solar research laboratory in Boulder City for the Desert Research Institute. The facility is currently conducting scientific studies of solar energy and its applications to Nevada and the Boulder City area. Mr. Buchanan further spearheaded the introduction of gaming technology courses at the community colleges which presently serve a large segment of the area population.

Mr. Buchanan was also instrumental in overseeing the inauguration of the community college outreach program allowing the people in Moapa Valley, Overton, Logandale and Searchlight direct access to community college classes near their homes. He intends to see the Community College Outreach Program is expanded in the coming years so that his

constituents who live outside the vicinity of the community colleges can have access to community college courses.

Mr. Buchanan has recently initiated plans for a high technology computer program with hopes of it becoming a frontrunner in its field. "We can realistically foresee our computer technology program as the most outstanding and progressive in Computer Science in the country," he stated. The curriculum would institute computer programs leading to Doctorial Degrees, which would lure high level technology firms to the Clark County area. Mr. Buchanan, a former nuclear physicist, is extremely interested in the new computer program and feels that it would enhance the academic standing of UNLV in the United States. Recently 1.5 million in funding was allocated by the Board of Regents for the initial acquisition of the basic computer hardware for the new program. "This concept, once fulfilled, will be most exciting educational

development in the University System ever," Buchanan added.

One of Mr. Buchanan's pet projects has been the establishment of a Law School at UNLV.

"I intend to actively pursue the Law School curriculum when funding and resources become available," he commented. During the past ten years, Mr. Buchanan has been strong force in the 'fair share's concept for funding allocations at UNLV as well as Clark County Community College, spearheading the assignment of monies to Southern Nevada whenever possible. He referred to the 200 million in construction over the past ten years, as well as the \$80 million in new development in Southern Nevada for the University System in the past year.

Mr. Buchanan, practicing attorney in Southern Nevada, is a graduate of United States Naval Academy at Annapolis. He also attended the University of New Mexico Graduate School majoring in Research & Development Management. He earned his Doctorate in Juris Prudence at Southern Methodist University Law School. He is a former Clark County Deputy District Attorney, and a former Special Prosecutor in Clark County. He served as an officer in the United States Air Force, specializing in the development of Nuclear Physics. Later, as a civilian, he was employed as a Nuclear Physicist at the Nevada Test Site.

He is a regular donor to the UNLV Scholarship Program.
