## TROOPS INTO

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- The last Harris Poll indicates that the majority of Americans by a margin of 76 - 14 percent, support Is-rael's military incursion into Lebanon with the objective to "have all non-Lebanese military powers -- Israel, Syria and the PLO -- leave that country and allow the Lebanese to rule themselves and to control their own country militarily.

But the poll continued that the majority of Americans oppose the sending of U.S. troops to act as a peacekeeping force in the 25 - mile buffer zone the Israelis want in south Lebanon in order to prevent the Palestine Liberation Organization from launching rocket and artillery assaults on northern Israeli settlements.

The poll surveyed 1,255 adults throughout the country by telephone and therefore did not have an indication of U.S. public opinion to the offer by President Reagan to send U.S. troops to Beirut to help evacuate the PLO. According to the poll, American public
