## JACKSON SAYS ARABS MAY NEGOTIATE

WASH. (WNS) ---Sen. Henry Jackson (D. Wash.) said that the defeat the Arab world has suffered in the Iranian - Iraqi war and in Lebanon should make them agreeable to more work with the United States and Israel for "rational accords" in the Mideast.

"Thoughtful Arabs should be more susceptible to negotia-tions," Jackson said in an appearance on CBS-TV's "Face The Nation," He said the current situation puts the U.S. on the "threshhold" of being able to work more successfully toward negotiations in the Middle East. Jackson expressed the hope that an autonomy agreement could now

reached which be would leave defense and foreign policy of the West Bank under Israeli control. He said that is "the only way that is going to work."

The Senator that the situation in Lebanon demonstrates that there is a greater need for Israel to consult with the U.S. on what it is going to do. He said that there had been "substantial erosion" in the United States for Israel because of the invasion of Lebanon but at the same time, "frustrated Americans" look with admiration that when the Israelis "seek to do something, they get it done. 
