Secret Witness will pay \$1,000 cash reward for information leading to the arrest & indictment of the person or persons who committed the murder.

BOMBING AND ARSON -- Cash Reward \$6,000, for arrest and indictment, \$1,000 from Secret Witness and \$5,000 from the insurance company. On April 15, 1982, a 1973 Cessna 421B (being number N209RP) was flown from Skyharbor Airport by the pilot with three passengers to the Tonapah Airport, Tonapah, Nevada. The aircraft landed at 7:01 P.M. on April 15, 1982. After being locked and left on the ramp for approximately three - and - one - half hours, an explosion occured in the cabin area, tearing the aircraft in two, after which time it caught on fire and burned.

Secret Witness will pay a \$1,000.00 cash reward to anyone that has information leading to the arrest and indictment of the person or persons who murdered James R. Kerr, Wt. Male, 71 - years - of - age at 207 No. 11th Street, Room 6, Moonlight Motel on June 7th, 1982. The victim had been tied up and gagged before he was murdered.
