HOW MCCLOSKEY WAS "USED" BY PLO CHIEF YASIR ARAFAT

WATT ADMITS BLUNDER

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Secretary of Interior James Watt told leaders of the Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith that he had "made a mistake" in sending a letter to Ambassador Moshe Arens of Israel stating that "If the liberals of the Jewish community join with other liberals of this nation to oppose these efforts, they will weaken our ability to be a good friend of Israel."

At his meeting, Watt was reported to have expressed his apologies and admitted that the Am-

SHAMIR CALLS IT "AN EXERCISE IN DECEIT"

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- An international controversy flared during the week of July 26-28 when a group of U.S. Congressmen came away from meeting with PLO chief Yasir Arafat in West Beirut, claiming that he had signed a document in their presence which amounted in effect to a commitment to recognize Israel. The document was later denied by Arafat of any such intention.

The incident occurred when Arafat met with five members of a six member Congressional delegation headed by Rep. Pete McCloskey (R. Calif.). According to reports from Beirut, McCloskey, a long time opponent of the policies of the Begin government, said the PLO leader "signed for his acceptance of all United Nations resolutions which include the right of Israel to exist." But Arafat promptly corrected the American lawmaker, saying the document he signed accepted "All UN resolutions concerning the Palestinian question."

During the past three years, the stage has been set in Nevada for new, clean industry. In many instances, businesses have opened up their doors for the first time in this state.
