JERUSALEM (WNS) -- An international controversy flared during the week of July 26-28 when a group of U.S. Congressmen came away from meeting with PLO chief Yasir Arafat in West Beirut, claiming that he had signed a document in their presence which amounted in effect to a commitment to recognize Israel. The document was later denied by Arafat of any such intention.

The incident occurred when Arafat met with five members of a six member Congressional delegation headed by Rep. Pete. McCloskey (R. Calif.). According to reports from Beirut, McCloskey, a long time opponent of the policies of the Begin government, said the PLO leader "signed for his acceptance of all United Nations resolutions which include the right of Israel to exist." But Arafat promptly corrected the American lawmaker, saying the document he signed accepted "All UN resolutions concerning the Palestinian question."
