Forces of Good and Evil

The conflict taking place in Lebanon is as much a struggle for the minds of people as it is a military battle. That struggle has now taken the form of a modern morality play.

In the medieval morality plays, all human conflict was portrayed as combat between the forces of good and evil, the children of light and those of darkness, Christ and Satan. And in that primitive scenario, the children of light were expected to destroy the forces of darkness forever.

That model is now being used by the PLO and their backers to portray the Jews of Israel as the new Nazis, the new anti - Christ. But in fact, it is the PLO that since 1975 has massacred about 100,000 Lebanese and Palestinian civilians. They have destroyed or terrorized whole villages. Those facts are being suppressed or ignored.

The current wave of media chic is recasting the PLO as innocent victims, children of light. Only the Israelis are pictured as ruthless destroyers, deserving of the wrath reserved for Satan.

This PLO revision of history is also seeking to eclipse the Nazi holocaust and its moral
claims on Christian society. If Christians can
be persuaded that Israelis are no better than
Nazis, then the world need no longer act fairly
to Jews and Israel.

If that willful perversion of history is allowed to take place, the moral wreckage wrought by the PLO will become as destructive to mankind as the human devastation that their terrorists have inflicted on Lebanon and the world community.



Major Blow to Terrorism

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- A Prominent Christian has declared that "the defeat of the PLO" deals "a major blow to international terrorism."

Dr. David Hyatt, a Catholic, serving as President of the National Conference of Christians and Jews, in a strong statement brought to the attention of this writer and others here at the UN, praised Israel's success in eliminating PLO terrorism from Lebanon, hub of international terrorism.



'The Better to Fool You With, My Dear'

"As a Catholic concerned about the survival of my Jewish brothers and sisters in Israel and the preservation of human rights in the Middle East," Dr. Hyatt declared, "I am appalled that some of my fellow Christians are now attacking Israel for its incursion into Lebanon,"

Stating that "the PLO has been a primary instrument of the Soviet Union for the training and arming of its subversive world - wide terrorist network," Dr. Hyatt was emphatic in noting that "Israeli's defeat of the PLO is a major blow to international terrorism." The elimination of the terrorists, he said, "will free many moderate West Bank Arabs to speak out in behalf of a negotiated Arab-Israeli peace that acknowledges Israel's right to exist without fear of PLO retribution. In the past the PLO has successfully silenced all Palestinian and Arab moderates by intimidation and murder."

Recounting past history, the dynamic Christian leader reminded the world that "the PLO was driven from Jordan by King Hussein after its members attempted to assassinate him and destroy his Government. They then retreated to Lebanon and have succeeded in turning that country into a battleground between Moslems and Christians and in essence affecting a PLO-Syrian take - over.

"No other country," he stressed, "has moved to help Israel to stop PLO terrorism -- not the United Nations, not a single one of the European NATO powers, not the UN -- and certainly not the Soviet Union which arms the PLO."

tory tax.

Another luring figure is that a property owner was taxed at the 15th highest per capita rate in America -- in the past. Now he's 38th, a drastic change.

Even our increased sales tax ranks about midway among the states.

The tax structure in this state has laid the foundation for new businesses and industries. Then we aggressively generated new and better opportunities for businesses.

For example, one such effort is the passage of a bill allowing the Department of Commerce to issue Industrial Development Revenue Bonds for the financing of new Construction, and the improvement and redevelopment of commercial projects in the state.

This program will enable the state to combat the effects of record - high interest rates, and the rising costs of construction throughout the nation.

In addition, I've worked closely with the state Department of Economic Development to actively seek new business and industry for the state. I have personally contacted dozens of business and industrial leaders in other states.

I'm proud but not satisfied with the strides we have made in the past three years. We have begun a new initiative in Nevada, a new thrust. It is necessary to continue in our efforts to promote industrial growth and economic diversification. Only a relentless, successful pursuit will satisfy me.

We have begun to build a better Nevada, Let's keep going.
