

**JACQUELINE WEXLER ELECTED PRESIDENT OF NCCJ**

NEW YORK -- Jacqueline Grennan Wexler, former President of Hunter College in New York City, has been elected by the Executive Board of the National Conference of Christians and Jews as its fifth President, it was announced by Irving Mitchell Felt, National Chairman of the NCCJ Executive Board.

The election followed a nationwide search begun after Dr. David Hyatt had announced his decision to retire from the presidency, effective October 1, 1982, for personal and family reasons.

The Selection Committee, which proposed Mrs. Wexler for the Executive Board's

consideration, consisted of Mr. Felt as Chairman of the Executive Board, Dr. Hyatt, and the four National Co-Chairmen, Messrs. V. J. Skutt, William F. May, Bernard J. Lasker and Nicholas V. Petrou.

Mrs. Wexler has been a member of the Executive Board and has served as Vice Chairwoman and Secretary of NCCJ since 1980. During the past year, she conducted a study of the mission, the administration and the governance structures of NCCJ and presented the results of that study at the NCCJ Annual Meeting of the Board of Trustees in March of this year.
