On the subject of "ONE MO'TIME," that an acting assignment for your be will Vegastars' reporter for the next few weeks, I joined the fine cast of YVONNE TALTON KER-SEY as Bertha, LYNNE CLIFTON-ALLEN as Ma Reed; ADJORA FAITH MCMILLAN as Thelma and RONALD "SMOKEY" STEVENS as Papa Du in the role of the Theatre Owner in that rollicking depiction of New Orleans music of the 20s. I attended a performance of the musical last Thursday in New York at the Village Gate Theatre in Greenwich Village, where the show, written by VERNEL BAG-NERIS, began. Now there are companies of "One Mo' Time" in London and Australia, plus the Sands here all playing to capacity audiences. The playbill of the Village Gate contained this description -- "Located on the corner of New Orleans' Iberville and Burgundy, The Lyric Theatre -- until destroyed by fire in 1927 -- nightly entertained in black vaudeville with such talents as BESSIE SMITH, MA RAINEY and others now immortal. Being on the T.O.B.A. circuit (Theatre Owners Booking Agency, or as the trade people had it, 'Tough On Black Asses,') the pay was low and the touring conditions tough
