THE OLD SYNAGOGUE IN CAIRO

Ezra Shahatah of Cairo, Egypt, deserves a medal from world Jewry.

When Gamal Nasser was president of Egypt, he shut down the ancient and venerated Ben Ezra Synagogue and forbad anyone to enter it. During that bleak and fanatic anti - Israel period in Egypt, Shahatah became a self-appointed Shamash (sexton), and managed surreptitiously to care for the precious Torah scrolls and the historic Genizah (hidden collection of sacred documents) located in the upper attic of the Synagogue. He did that entirely on his own as a labor of love, without any financial support from outside sources. Under President Sadat, Ben Ezra Synagogue was reopened and it is now visited mainly by Jewish tourists.

Last month, when I visited the Synagogue in

Old Cairo, Shahatah guided me trhough the awe-some treasures of the holy place. First, he showed me the underground canal which is believed to be the spot in the Nile River where Pharaoh's daughter had the infant Moses lifted from the churning waters. Tradition holds that Moses later prayed here before he led the Israelites out of Egypt.

It is also believed that the Prophet Jeremiah fled here in the sixth century BCE from Babylonia and prayed here.
