ANT-JEWISH TERRORISM IN FRANCE

The latest assault on the Jewish community of France should invoke a deep sense of outrage and condemnation from all Americans. This incident is another of the many examples of international terrorism and its murderous attempts to disrupt national stability and order and to use intimidation as an influencing factor. The attack on France's best known Jewish restaurant in the Jewish quarter of Paris, was particularly horrendous because of the blantant disregard of innocent civilian life and its clearly anti - Jewish posture.

The attack at Goldenberg's restaurant in the heart of the Rue de Rosiers, Paris's old Jewish quarter in which poor Jews have lived for more than 100 years, occurred at the lunch hour when the shop was crowded with people. Four men, waiting in the restaurant, suddenly drew out from under their coats submachineguns and sprayed the large restaurant and delicatessen store. The terrorists continued shooting while running through the maze of narrow alleys, leaving behind a trail of dead and wounded. When the smoke cleared, six people, two American

tourists among them, were killed while 22 remain hospitalized, many critically.

Many officials in the Jewish community of France feel that the incident is a result of the anti - Israeli posture of the government of Pre-sident Francois Mitterrand in the conflict in Lebanon. Others have blamed the press for its slanted coverage of the Lebanon fighting which has created a climate of incitement. Nevertheless, this cowardly attack by terrorists on civilians removed from the fighting and warfare of the Middle East is a problem the Mitterrand Administration must tackle immediately. But if the French government is unable to protect its citizens, the Jews of France may have to resort to other means to secure their interests and livelihood.

Argov suffered severe head injuries in the attack.

He was taken from the London hospital to the airport to board jet under an El Al tight security precautions. He travelled to Israel on a stretcher, accompanied by his wife, a doctor and a nurse. Argov is reported to know that Israel has been fighting a war in Lebanon, but it is not known whether he is aware that it was the terrorist

The WCC which comprises 400 churches of the Protestant, Greek Orthodox and Catholic faiths, blamed Israel for the plight of the refugees and homeless and demanded an immediate lifting of its siege of West Beirut. The WCC seems to have conspicuously relieved the Arab states of any blame for the Palestinian problem and also failed to mention the involvement of any other party besides Israel with having inflicted suffering on the people of Lebanon. It has obliterated quickly any memory of the military terrorists' training centers the PLO used Palestinian refugee camps for or the placing of munitions dumps in the basements of schools, mosques and churches. Furthermore, since when has the Syrian occupation of a once sovereign

Lebanon been rewritten from the WCC history books?

The WCC's claim that Israel has barred humanitarian aid from reaching south Lebanon has been reported by officials as being contrary to the facts. Also widely reported, to the contrary of the WCC report, is that Red Cross representatives have been granted access to visit terrorists detained in camps in south Lebanon by the Israeli forces. No mention in the report either of the rehabilitation efforts underway now in liberated south Lebanon.

The anti - Israel stance of the delegation's report heaps fallacy upon fallacy to the actual events in Lebanon and presents the occupying PLO as some sort of angelic savior to the people in the region. The WCC, beyond all rational reasoning, appears to place the blame for the thousands of innocent people killed prior to the Israeli action on the shoulders of the Israeli people. The WCC should re-evaluate the credibility of its delegation, recheck its files, refresh its memory and stop pontificating to the world for the PLO that terrorized Lebanon and inflicted untold suffering on the people of Israel and Lebanon.
