LORETTA BOWMAN RUNS AGAIN FOR COUNTY CLERK

Loretta Bowman is recognized throughout the United States as an outstanding and progressive county clerk. She has served as Director, Secretary - Treasurer, Vice President and President of the National Association of County Clerks and Records (NACRC) and is currently a Director of NACRC. Since 1966 she has been Secretary - Treasurer of the County Fiscal Officers Association of the State of Nevada and is an active member of the National Association of County Officials. Loretta is a native Nevadan, born in Logandale and graduated from Moapa Valley High School at Overton. Since 1947 when she was hired as a Deputy Clerk, Loretta has been an inseparable part of the County Clerk's Office. In 1947, there were 14 employees. Today, as the County Clerk, Loretta is responsible for directing a staff of 125 employees. The duties of the department have been and are multiplying faster than the population of Clark County. The County Clerk is an elected official serving a four-year term. Additional duties of the office are Ex-Officio Clerk of the Eighth Judicial District Court; Board of the County Commissioners; Board of Equalization; Clark County Liquor and Gaming Licensing Board; Kyle Canyon Water District; Clark County Sanitation District; General Obligation Bond Commission; Civil Service Board and Southern Nevada Memorial Hospital. The workload of the County Clerk's Office has doubled in the past ten years. The County Clerk spends many hours in training and continuing education programs to be able

to efficiently handle the enormous responsibilities of the office. Not only does the clerk handle the enormous workload critical to the Judicial System's operation, the Clerk is also accountable for hundreds of thousands of dollars which comes through her office for everything from bail bonds and jury fees to condemnation monies and reporters' fees. Every dollar of these monies must be accurately accounted for. It is big business and takes an experienced professional to run it. With Loretta Bowman's knowledge and experience she has helped to make Nevada's Judicial System one of the most modern and efficient in the nation.

PHIL LAMPKIN FILES FOR ASSEMBLY

Because of the many problems facing us in Nevada and Clark County and as a deeply concerned citizen Phil Lampkin, a ten-year resident is a candidate for the State Assembly District 15. Among some of his most important priorities are crime, taxation, education, victim's rights, utility rates, unemployment and senior citizens care. On crime and victim's rights Lampkin will introduce legislation for mandated stiff penalties for

criminals convicted of a felony including rape who use a lethal weapon in the commission of such a crime. He advocates additional sentences for repeat offenders and crimes against the elderly. He also supports legislation requiring criminals to make restitution to those they harm and victims or victim's families must have a say in the parole of their assailants. Lampkin believes the present tax structure is inequitable and will support a special election by the people to roll back the sales tax. The escalating utility rates are causing a severe hardship on the elderly and those on fixed incomes. In order for the Public Service Commission to be more responsive to the public he feels they should be elected instead of

appointed by the Governor or if appointed they should divest themselves of any holdings they might have in a utility company. Phil Lampkin, a Democrat, attended the University of California and George Washington University. He is a member of the Board of Directors of the National Kidney Foundation of Nevada and President of the University Crest Homeowners Association. During his military

service he was a Staff Officer and retired as a Lt. Colonel. He holds the Legion of Honor of the Order of DeMolay.
