5743 COULD BRING LASTING PEACE - THE TIME HAS COME!

Peace in the Middle East has eluded Israel since its birth in 1948. But as the Jewish world enters the new year -- 5743 -- the possibility that peace will prevail is greater than ever.

The "Peace for Galilee" operation which Israel launched June 6 and concluded 10 weeks later, was a major achievement for the Jewish State -- and for the world at large. It broke the military backbone of the terrorist PLO and destroyed its infrastructure. It laid the foundation for a stable and viable government in Lebanon and removed Soviet influence in the region. Most of all, international terrorism was dealt a telling blow.

But this only poses the possibilities inherent in the success of the Lebanon operation. The year 5743 will continue to be a trying time for Israel and the world Jewish community.

There are many nettling problems within Israel that need to be solved. The struggle for economic and social stability and well-being will be priority items; reduction of triple - digit inflation; easing of tensions between the Ashkenazic and Sephardic communities; intensification of foreign trade; growing involvement of women on decision-making levels; greater subsidization of medical and scientific research; granting status in religious life to the conservative and Reform movements of Judaism.

On the international front, Israel will be immersed in the Camp David peace process;

WASHINGTON -- Events of the past few weeks now indicate that our friends and allies in Israel may move much closer to achieving their long - sought - after goal of peace. War and killing have become too much of a way of life in the Middle East.

The withdrawal of all foreign military units from Lebanon may bring a stability to that area that the Lebanese have not seen since the civil war of 1975 and 1976.

There has been some criticism of the Israelis for their decisive action in bringing an end to the terrorism, but I feel their action has understandable historic roots. The Israelis amassed one big assault to retaliate for a de-

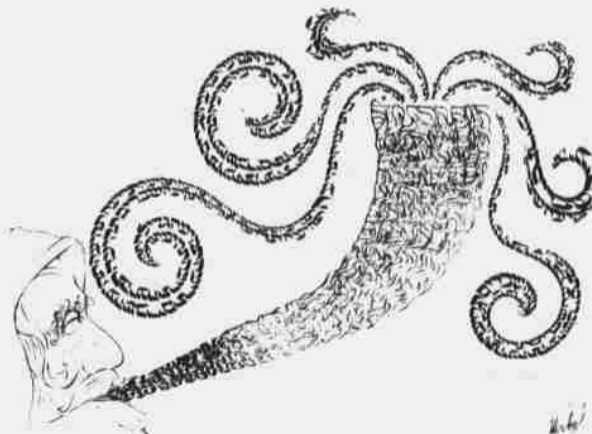
