

# JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

**JERUSALEM (WNS)** -- Israel allowed the Egyptian ship, Lotus, which was anchored in the Beirut harbor, to unload some 2,000 tons of food and medical supplies. The ship was not permitted to unload for a few days because several leaders of parties in Egypt opposed to Israel were aboard and planned to go ashore to protest against Israel's military actions in Lebanon. Israeli officials decided to allow the unloading in order to get the medical supplies distributed.

**WASHINGTON (WNS)** -- Legislation to rescind the Most Favored Nation trade status for Rumania, House Resolution No. 521, introduced by Rep. Robert Dornan (R. Calif.), went to the floor of the House. However, the Representatives decided to postpone voting on this bill indefinitely, thus automatically continuing MFN status for Rumania as well as for the People's Republic of China and Hungary for another full year.

**SAN FRANCISCO (WNS)** -- The Bay Area Council of the Soviet Jewry reported that Lenin-grad refusenik Irina Jacobson has received permission to leave the Soviet Union. Jacobson, the widow of the famed choreographer Leonid Jacobson, worked with the Kirov Ballet Theater until her husband's death.

**NEW YORK (WNS)** -- The director of the Aliya Center of North America, Moshe Schechter, said that some 173 new immigrants and returning Israelis are preparing for imminent departure for Israel from New York, continuing the upward trend of aliya from North America. Schechter said the total for August would exceed 600 olim -- the highest monthly total in over two years.

**JERUSALEM (WNS)** -- The Likud coalition continues to maintain a large lead over the opposition Labor Party among Israelis, according to the latest opinion poll published here.

**JERUSALEM (WNS)** -- Two American Congressmen met with Premier Menachem Begin and afterwards expressed support for Israel's military action in Lebanon. Rep. Mario Biaggi (D. N.Y.) expressed confidence that Israel's action would not reduce Congressional support for economic aid to Israel, saying, "given the facts in a more accurate presentation of what has occurred...we will reconstitute the kind of support Israel has traditionally enjoyed." Discussing the criticism of Israel in the American news media, Rep. James Scheuer (D. N.Y.) SAID: "This too shall pass."

**NEW YORK (WNS)** -- A delegation of Jewish leaders who met with Secretary of State George Shultz and members of his staff for more than two hours in Washington, urged the United States to influence Jordan to join the Middle East process and to help "find Palestinians who represent their people" to negotiate with Israel. Julius Berman, chairman of the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations, who headed the 13 member delegation, said that Shultz was mostly interested in hearing the views of the Jewish leaders.
