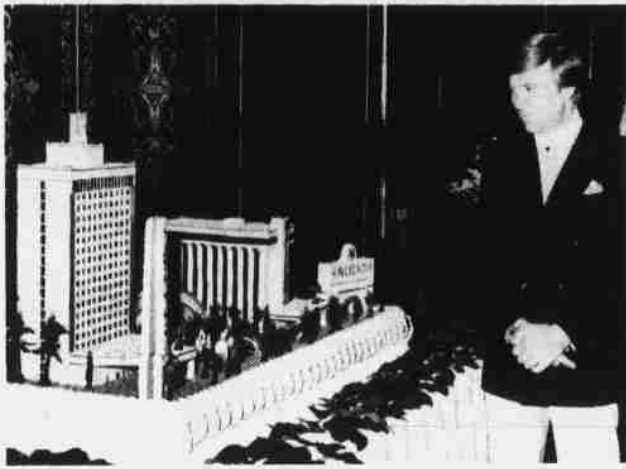


BOTH ENDS OF THE STRIP

JEWISH NEW YEAR PRAYER: "PEACE IN THE MIDDLE EAST"

strengthening its ties with the United States and Western Europe for the purpose of ensuring peace in the region and maintaining amicable diplomatic relations; and furthering its normalization with Egypt.

Jews in diaspora communities will also be facing Herculean tasks, including combatting assimilation and intermarriage by infusing the Jewish youth with the mores and traditions of Judaism. It will have to devise ways to attract and to keep the young people from becoming estranged from Jewish values. This will require a great deal of tenacity on the part of the secular and religious leaders. It will also require a great deal of perspicacity in order to counter the nefarious cults and "isms" that seem so attractive to so many Jewish youths.

But Israel and the Jewish communities world wide will also have to hone in on the continuing plight of Jews in the Soviet Union, in Arab lands and in countries where democracy has been cast aside. A great deal of work will have to be done to combat nascent and rampant anti-Semitism.

The feeling that "Es is shver tzu zein a Yid" (It is difficult to be a Jew) crops up as the litany of problems confronting Jews are stated and restated. But the problems continue to a large extent because the Jews themselves tend to ignore or minimize them until -- a bomb explodes in a Jewish restaurant, a youngster is enticed into a cult, swastikas and Nazi graffiti appear on buildings, a Soviet Jew is arrested and imprisoned, anti-Jewish rallies take place.

The time to cope with these problems is before they take place and at the roots. It does little good to react after "the cow is let out of the barn." Unfortunately, the tendency is for Jews to react. They must learn to anticipate, based on realistic assessments of events, and to act before a scratch becomes gangrene. It may be more difficult to mobilize forces to avert a danger than to gather forces to respond to a tragedy. But perhaps tragedies can be averted if the forces of evil are cut off at the pass. It should be tried. It's an idea, it seems, whose time is imperative.

DR. NAHUM GOLDMAN DEAD AT 87

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Dr. Nahum Goldmann, the fiery and often controversial World Zionist leader, died in a hospital in Bad Reichenhall, West Germany, at the age of 87. He was buried on Mt. Herzl Sept. 2. According to a spokesman for the hospital, Goldmann entered the hospital suffering from a serious illness, but would not disclose the cause of death.

Goldmann, who was a prominent member of virtually every international Zionist and Jewish organization in existence, was the co-founder of the World Jewish Congress in 1949 and its president until a few years ago when he was succeeded by Philip Klutznick and named honorary president.

He was also President of the World Zionist Organization from 1956 to 1968 and President of the Memorial Foundation for Jewish Culture; the

Conference on Jewish Material Claims Against Germany, and Beth Hatefusoith in Tel Aviv, the Nahum Goldmann Museum of

the Diaspora.

Goldmann was frequently at odds with Israel's leaders, both Labor and Likud. Some of his fiercest controversies were with Premier David Ben Gurion over the relationship between the Jewish State and the Galut.

During World War II, Goldman was a prime force within the Zionist movement in the United States, tirelessly arguing for America's help in the

creation of a Jewish Homeland. A number of historians give credit to Goldmann for his intense lobbying of the Truman Administration for support of the so-called Partition Plan to establish an independent Jewish State in Palestine. Final, strong support of the United States for the plan helped lead to the establishment of Israel in 1948.

Goldmann was an unyielding opponent of the government of Premier Menachem

Began. He ran into a storm of criticism when he, Klutznick and former French Premier Pierre Mendes-France issued a joint statement last month calling on Israel and the PLO to mutually recognize each other to achieve peace in the Middle East.

He managed throughout the years after the State of Israel was founded to irritate almost every Israeli leader he dealt with.
