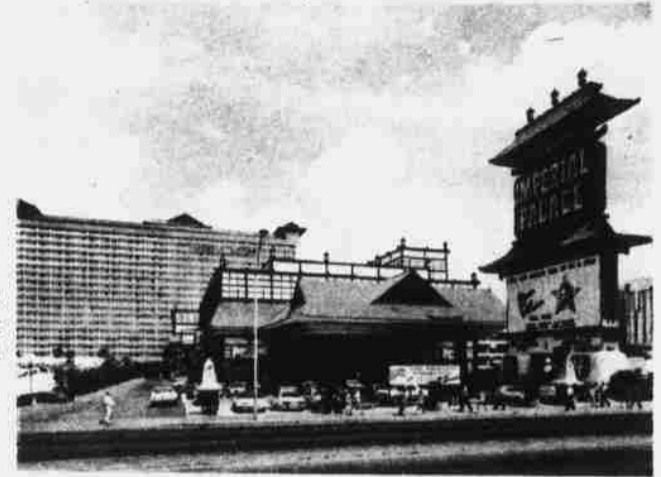


**IMPERIAL PALACE IS 6TH LARGEST**

**"A CHORUS LINE" RETURNS TO DESERT INN**

For those who missed it and those who loved it, "A Chorus Line" -- one of the most sensational musicals of all time -- is singing and dancing again in Las Vegas. The show's International Company has returned to the Desert Inn's Crystal Room for a limited engagement.

The proud recipient of the New York Drama Critic's Award, nine Tony Awards and a Pulitzer Prize, "A Chorus Line" played to standing-room-only audiences during two

Conceived, choreographed and directed by Michael Bennett, this musical is a true-to-life sketch of the lives and experiences of Broadway's gypsies, chorus dancers who hoof out a precarious living on the Broadway stage. "A Chorus Line" plays twice nightly in the Crystal Room at 7 P.M. and 11 P.M. The showroom is dark Mondays.
