But nevertheless, according to a report in Maariv, Israel has had extensive contacts with the new Lebanese President. The Maariv report said Gemayel held several secret meetings with Israeli leaders recently, including some in Tel Aviv, during the "Peace for Galilee" operation. The paper reported the Gemayel began his series of visits to Issecrets rael in 1976. He met with various Israeli personalities, including Labor Party chairman Shimon Peres who at the time was Defense Minister in the government of Yitzhak Rabin. In 1976, when Peres launched policy "good fence" along the border with Lebanon, and extended Israeli aid to the Phalangist forces in Lebanon, Gemayel visited Peres at his home in Tel Aviv.

Mideast experts in Israel expressed satisfaction with Gemayel's election and others noted Gemayel's election portended a significant change in the life of Lebanon, with prospects for a strong and stable central government. Gemayel, experts pointed out, won a majority vote in Parliament despite death threats and terror against Deputies voting for him. -- mount a successful campaign to capture the tourism potential of the 1984 Summer Olympics to held in Los be Angeles,

-- establish a Nevada Tourism Travel Council composed of knowledgeable representatives of the industry to assist in promoting Nevada.

-- create a state data system to protimely inforvide mation to business, industry and government.

Bryan plans a three - pronged approach to economic development. First, the state must strengthen its existing economic base; iden-tify potential "spin-off" industries; and target clean new business to bring jobs

to Nevada.
